Launching in PNDA Week in November 2017, a new community network in the South West, Western Australia called Radiance Network South West. It is a community network connecting parents to local services to support emotional wellbeing during early parenthood. The network provides information about local support services in the Busselton area for parents and expectant mums and dads as well as running The Radiance Network Support Group and Mother Baby Nurture groups, a 10 week group supporting mothers and their babies through the first few months.

The Radiance Network South West was made possible from a community grant from an individual and a small grant from WA Primary health Network and a partnership between South West Women's Health & Information Centre and LAMP Inc. The support network is designed to help parents in the region improve their emotional wellbeing as they journey into parenthood The Busselton based community network runs plans to secure funding in the future to be able to create support groups in other communities in the South West Region.
