- Open data is not just about data
 - Replication file (Martel 2016) describes the data, statistical code, and documentation required to meaningfully use “open data”
 - Registration, data management/repository, open access
- Time to move beyond policies
 - Lack of enforcement
 - Little research community interest
- Funders hold carrots and sticks
 - Push button replication of draft results
 - Open data challenges
