

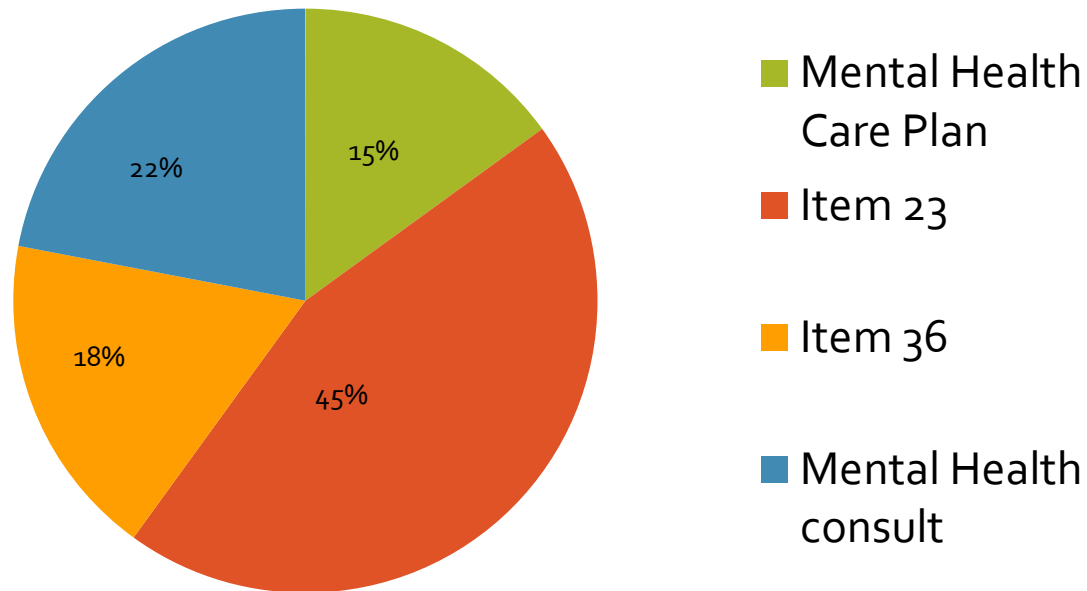

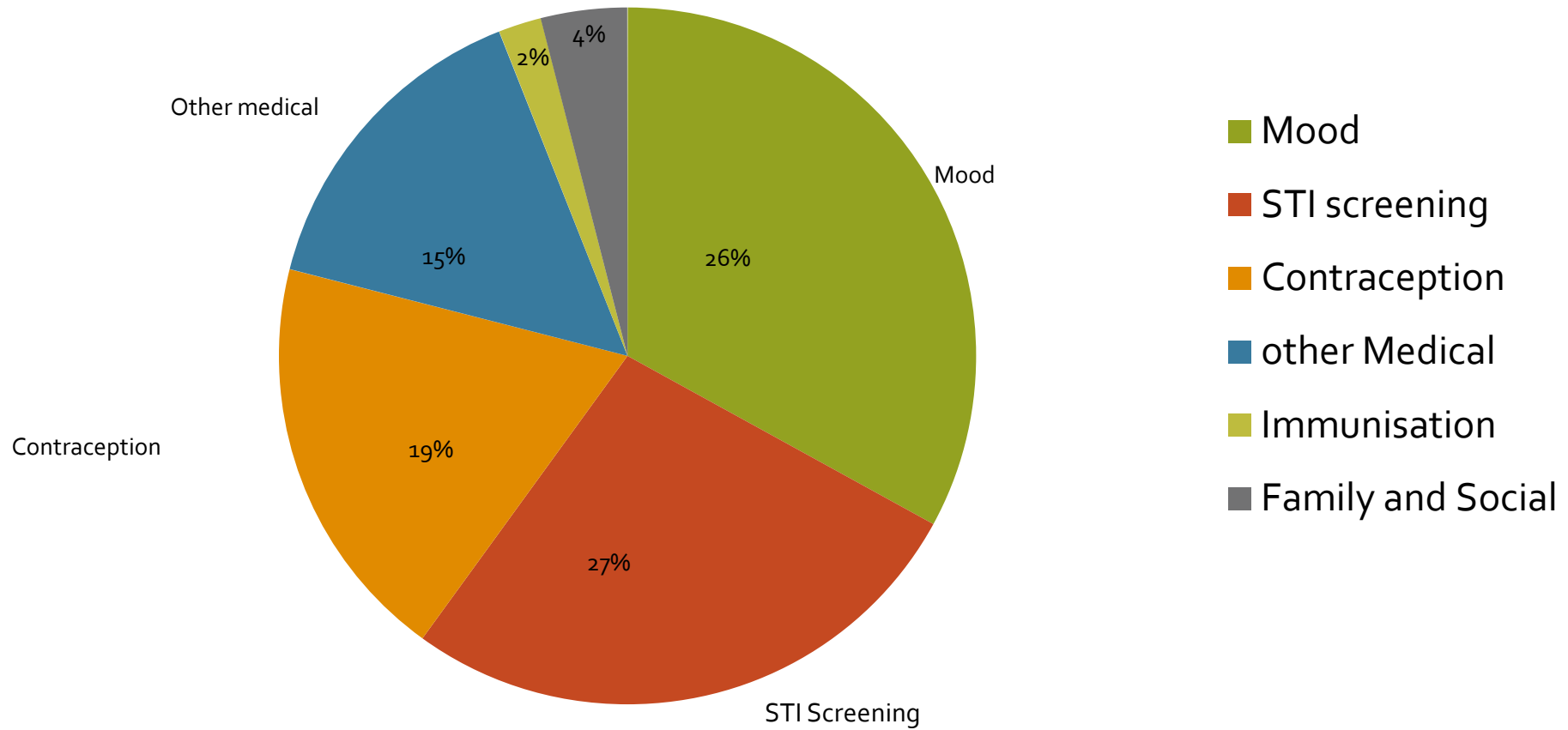
# How we help people

- This led to 370 follow-up visits in our practice

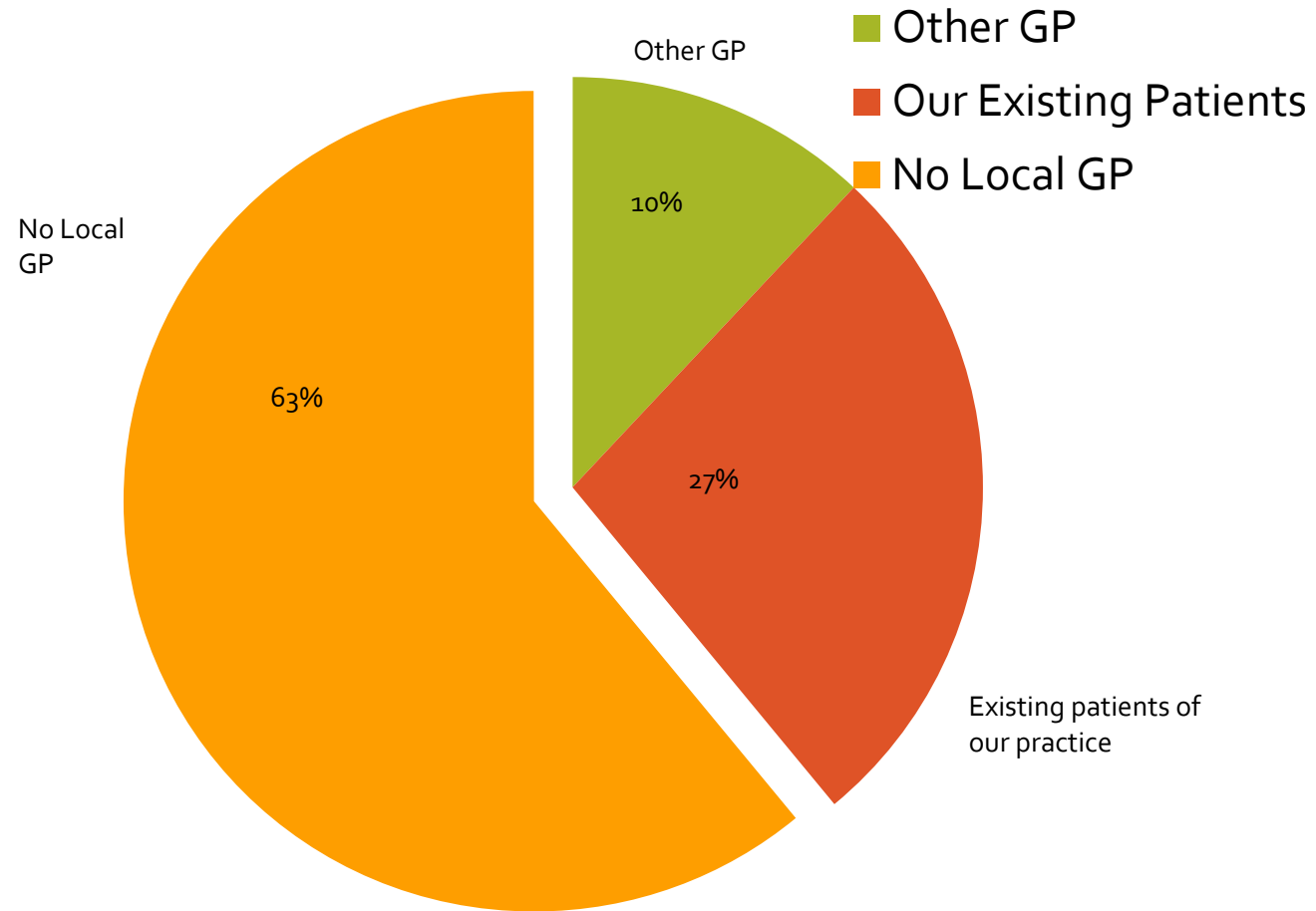
**Flow on visits**
