



## AUSTRALIAN MADE PACKAGE CHEAT SHEET

“The Australian Made Pavilion” is a walk-on stand package provided by the Organiser. The package is purchased at the time of booking and constitutes part of the contract to participate.

There are two ways to have your shell scheme setup:

Australian Made <b>with</b> fascia	
	
Power Point	1 x 4amp
Walls	Black Corinthian panels 2.4m in height
Lighting	2 spotlights per 9 sqms - Run on a track behind fascia sign
Metal Fascia Structure	Included - runs along front edge of stand
Standard Fascia Sign	Included - displays business name and stand number
<b>OPTIONAL - Carpet</b>	Plum colour

Australian Made <b>without</b> fascia	
	
Power Point	1 x 4amp
Walls	Black Corinthian panels 2.4m in height
Lighting	1 spotlight per 9 sqms - Connected on an arm to the back wall
Metal Fascia Structure	<b>Not included</b>
Standard Fascia Sign	Included and attached to the back wall – displays business name and stand number
<b>OPTIONAL - Carpet</b>	Plum colour

### IMPORTANT NOTES

- Allow 20mm thickness for each wall panel as contracted dimensions are the external dimensions of the stand.
- Standard wall height is 2.4 metres. The reverse side of any custom walling panels or items above the standard height must be dressed in either black or white to minimise the impact on surrounding exhibitors.
- To remove or modify any part of a shell scheme stand the official stand builder (Harry the Hirer) must be notified directly and charges may apply.
- For stands without a fascia, it is a mandated safety requirement that a 50cm support panel (nib) is placed every 3 metres of a lineal wall and will project into stands.

- Under no circumstances are support panel (nibs) to be removed without the official stand builders (Harry the Hirer) present to remove them for you. Please see the Harry the Hirer service desk onsite to request a nib removal or movement.

### **ATTACH TO WALLS**

There are particular ways to attach to these wall panels. Please contact Harry the Hirer directly for assistance in attaching to your walls including what materials are best to be used for your specific requirement.

Here are some standard materials / items which can and cannot be used on the black Corinthian wall panels.

<b>Items which CAN be used on Corinthian wall panels:</b>	<b>Items which CANNOT be used on Corinthian wall panels:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double-sided Velcro</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Screws, nails or bolts</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Staples</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Blue Tac</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pins</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Paint</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shelving and display grids</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double-sided tape</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Angle drive picture hooks</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Marker, pen or pencil mark</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Thumb tacks</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Liquids</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Small nails (up to 25mm long)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No cutting or drilling</li></ul>
