



- Professionals like us as contributors or cause of oppression








'Pathology' vs Neurodiversity

- Hold diagnostic labels lightly

Integration – what could this look like in your practice?

Involve	•disabled people to consult on the accessibility of your practice
Ask about	•Ask about accessibility needs
Avoid	•Avoid penalties for accessibility needs such as telehealth
Provide	Provide alternative options for increased access
Offer	• Proactively offer accessible ideas and norms
Have	•Have fidget toys around
Ask about	•Ask about language
Learn	•Learn from disabled people
Learn about	•Learn about ableism
co-design	•policies, treatment plans & formulations
Rethink	•what is 'normal' 'acceptable' and 'helpful'
Prioritise	•Accessibility and inclusion




