## **Background**


- Stigma Indicators Project
  - Funded by Australian Government Department of Health
  - Develop indicator of stigma among priority groups identified by National Strategies
    - Gay and other men who have sex with men
    - People who inject drugs
    - > People living with HIV
    - People living with viral hepatitis
    - People who engage in sex work

 People living with hepatitis C and people who inject drugs




