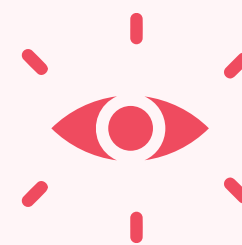

## Information

- All people across Aotearoa New Zealand will have access to impartial contraception information for when they need it.



## Accessibility

- Information on free or subsidised contraception services and eligibility criteria to help reduce access barriers.
- Interactive map of service providers across Aotearoa including what contraception services they deliver and if they offer free or subsidised services.



## Clinical Network

- Aotearoa-wide provider network for healthcare practitioners delivering contraception services providing access to news, events, and information.

# Our Kaupapa (work)

*Me aro koe ki te hā o Hineahuone*



The whakataukākī reflects the synergy between wāhine and whenua in the Māori world view. Amongst many iwi in Aotearoa, Hineahuone was the first woman created from the soil of Kurawaka by Tāne Māhuta with the support of his siblings, who each gifted her parts of their essence to bring her to life. Hineahuone and Tāne pro-created Hinetitama. In terms of fertility from a Māori perspective, Hineahuone reflects the wellbeing of wāhine Māori. For Protected&Proud, this whakataukākī is about the gift of life that Hineahuone began and pro-choice.

# CONSUMER INSIGHT

People across Aotearoa New Zealand **want to be involved in decision-making** when it comes to sexual and reproductive health, and **the role of the healthcare practitioner in enabling this is critical** to people being able to have autonomy over their body.

- Access to information about all contraception options
- Informed decision-making to make the right choice for them
- Option to choose where they go for services
- Want services to be accessible (considerations: mode, cost, operating times, high quality, inclusive and culturally safe)

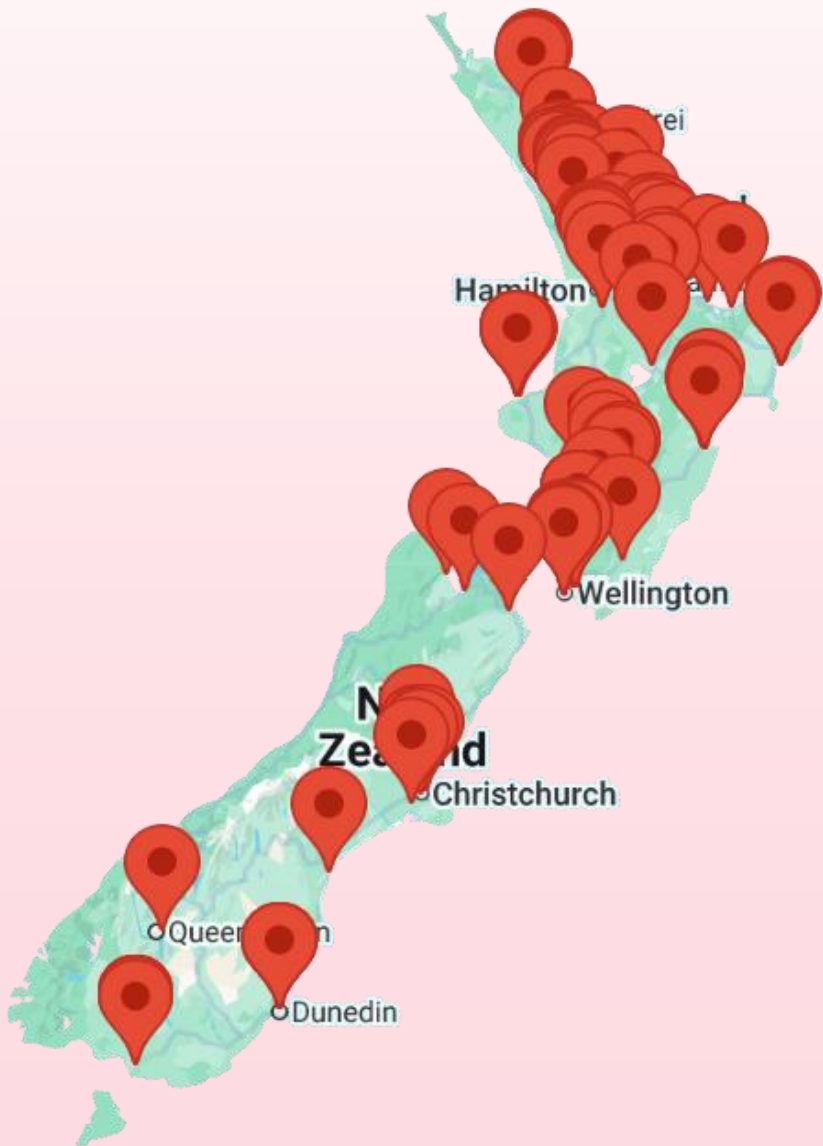
# HCP Network

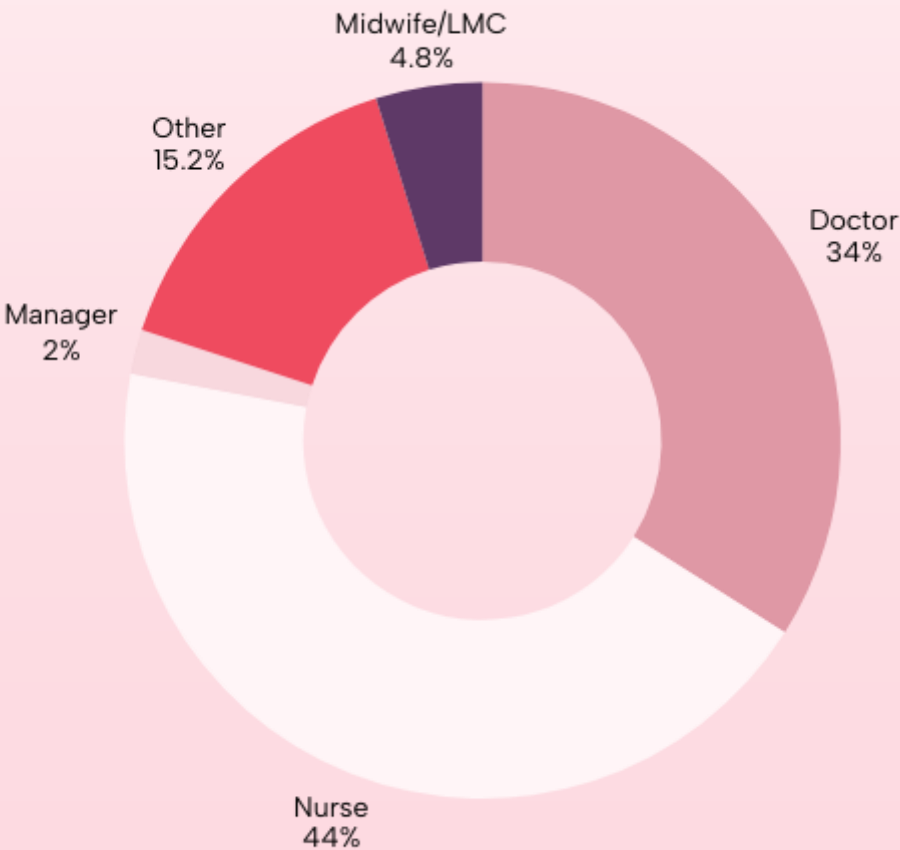
