Background

- Hep C Eradication is NOT limited by drug efficacy, but by taking cures to the disengaged
- Without targeting the marginalised patients on society's peripheries, eradication will fail.
- We aimed to explore barriers to Hep C cure
- Review of 40 consecutive Hep C patients at Medeco Inala re barriers to Hep C Cure
- Our aim was to define barriers to Hep C treatment and then design a project to take cures to the people in most need
- WE looked at patient driven and DR driven factors
- Patient factors
- A. Absolute chaos
- B. Fear of IV access
- C. Cash flow-taxi, bus, parking, private specialists,
- D. The public hospital waiting times are long
- E. Fear of SE'S
- F. Judgemental attitudes of hospital staff
- There are DR factors too, but we can chat about these later.

What we do with the Hep C Kombi

- 1978 cream coloured VW Kombi called DJ Funk
- Fold up chairs and tables
- Team: 2 GPs (roguishly handsome), a fibroscanning RN (world's best), QML phlebotomist (world class)
- Target rich venues: Rough sleeping locations, hostels, drug rehab centres, drop in centres, the streets
- Mornings, arvos, evenings til late
- Publicity through the venues- flyers, facebook machine, twitter
- We run on a 4 weeks rotating roster
- 2 stop shop-Visit 1: GP review, path, fibroscan
- Visit 2: review results, give script, provide follow up (path forms for 12 wk post Tx and GIT r/v if cirrhotic)

Finding Kombi Solutions

- **A.** *Absolute chaos-* Immediacy is vital. Start Tx right here, right now. Two step process. We take the cure to the people that need it.
- **B.** *Fear of IV access dramas* Strike while iron is hot with an excellent phlebotomist; femoral vein access; let them do their own bloods
- **C. Cash flow-** Minimise out of pockets. Provide financial incentives to be tested/treated encourages people. \$20 Woolies vouchers. Other free stuff (toiletries, blankets, beanies, M and Ms)
- **D.** The public hospital waiting times are long- Starting the ball rolling on the first visit is imperative. Our wait time is 20 mins, max. Compares well to public hospital lists
- E. Fear of SE'S- Addressing these fears at the first instance is vital.
- **F. Judgemental attitudes of hospital staff-** Come in a 1978 cream coloured VW Kombi wearing pink flamingo Hawaiian shirts + R'n'R
- People that own Kombis don't do statistics, we just judge the vibe. But 700 occasions of service. Over 100 cures in first 9 months.
