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## Hepatitis B

**234,000 people living with CHB in 2017**

**64% diagnosed – 36% undiagnosed**

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## Hepatitis B

**20% of those diagnosed are engaged in care**  
**(2022 national strategy target is 50%)**

**8% are receiving treatment**  
**(2022 target is 20%)**

**Minimal increases between 2016 and 2017**

## Hepatitis C

**WHO elimination goals**

**By 2030 in Australia and by 2028 in NSW**



### Three main elimination goals by 2030:

- 80% reduction in new HCV transmissions
- 65% reduction in mortality
- 80% on HCV DAA treatment



- GP mobilisation, education, incentivisation
- Ongoing, targeted PLUS broad awareness campaigns
- Peer based programs
- Greater nurse involvement
- Mobile outreach – EASY to access
- Greater system capacity in secure settings



## CONCLUSION

- **Maintain momentum – do not end successful programs**
- **Increase funding to achieve ALL elimination goals**
- **Fund hepatitis B community programs**
