## REPRODUCTIVE COERCION AND ABUSE AMONG A REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLE OF AUSTRALIAN ADULTS: THE THIRD AUSTRALIAN STUDY OF HEALTH AND RELATIONSHIPS

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#### **Background:**

Reproductive coercion and abuse (RCA) involve behaviours used to control a person's reproductive autonomy. We provide the first population-based estimates of the prevalence and correlates of RCA in Australia.

#### Methods:

We analysed cross-sectional survey data from a nationally representative sample of 7,229 adults aged 16-69 years, collected via computer-assisted telephone interviews in the Third Australian Study of Health and Relationships. Women who had engaged in vaginal intercourse (n=3,459) were queried about any partner interference with contraception and forced sterilisation/contraception; those with a history of pregnancy (n=2,477) were asked about coerced abortion and forced continuation of pregnancy. Men (n=3,490) were queried about forced vasectomy; those who had engaged in vaginal intercourse (n=3,127) were asked about partner interference with contraception (conceptually distinct from RCA). Logistic regression identified correlates.

#### **Results:**

Among women, the most prevalent form of RCA was coerced abortion [5.6% (95% CI: 4.5-6.9)], followed by partner interference with contraception [4.7% (3.9-5.6)], forced sterilisation/contraception [2.5% (1.9-3.3)], and forced continuation of pregnancy [2.1% (1.6-2.9)]. Among men, forced vasectomy showed a comparable prevalence to forced sterilisation [1.9% (1.43-2.44)] and partner interference with contraception was common

[9.1% (8.0-10.4)]. RCA was predominantly perpetrated by a partner, although women were more likely than men to report experiencing RCA from a parent and other family member. For both women and men, logistic regression showed a strong positive association between RCA and several social determinants of health (e.g., disability, financial hardship, unstable housing, incarceration, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status, bisexuality), history of substance use, having experienced sexual and intimate partner violence, reporting ever having an STI, young maternal age at first pregnancy, and poor general health, psychological distress, and anxiety during sex.

## Conclusion:

Approximately 5% of Australians report RCA, with marginalised communities disproportionately affected. RCA intersects with various forms of violence and has adverse effects on physical, sexual, and mental health.
