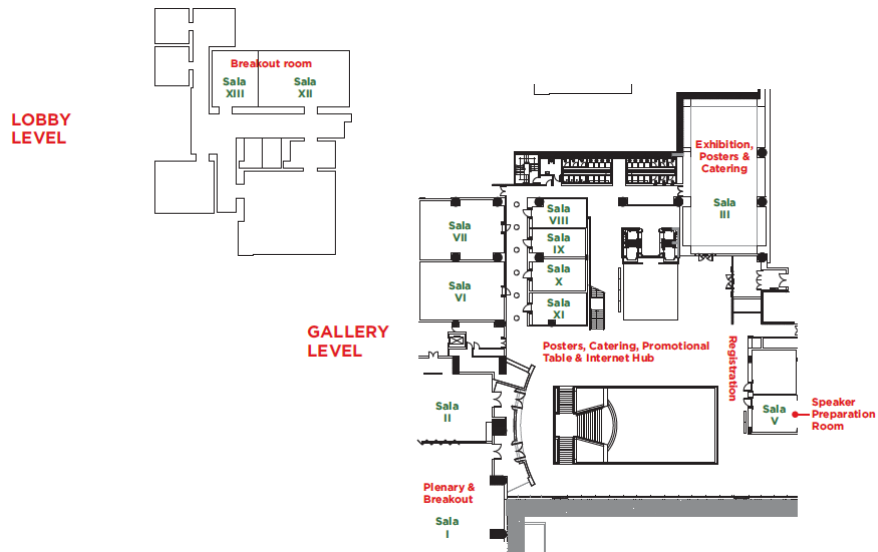

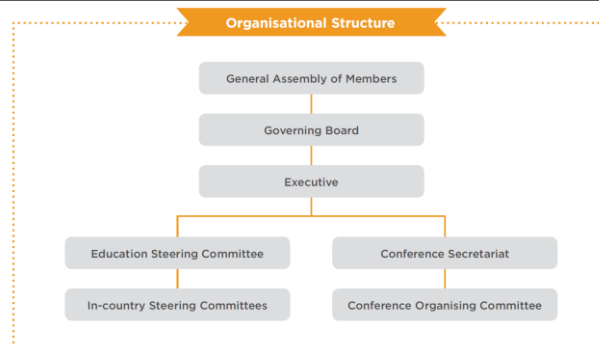
What is INHSU?

 - Communications


