- HCV infection (~1% in the past, 100 000)







- Language is important
- We have a very strong community presence which is incredibly important and adds to the expertise brought from lived experience
- Please try to avoid potentially stigmatizing and discriminatory language, such as p-wid, transmitters, addict, junkie, etc.
- For example, when using an acronym in slides, such as PWID, just say "people who inject drugs"
