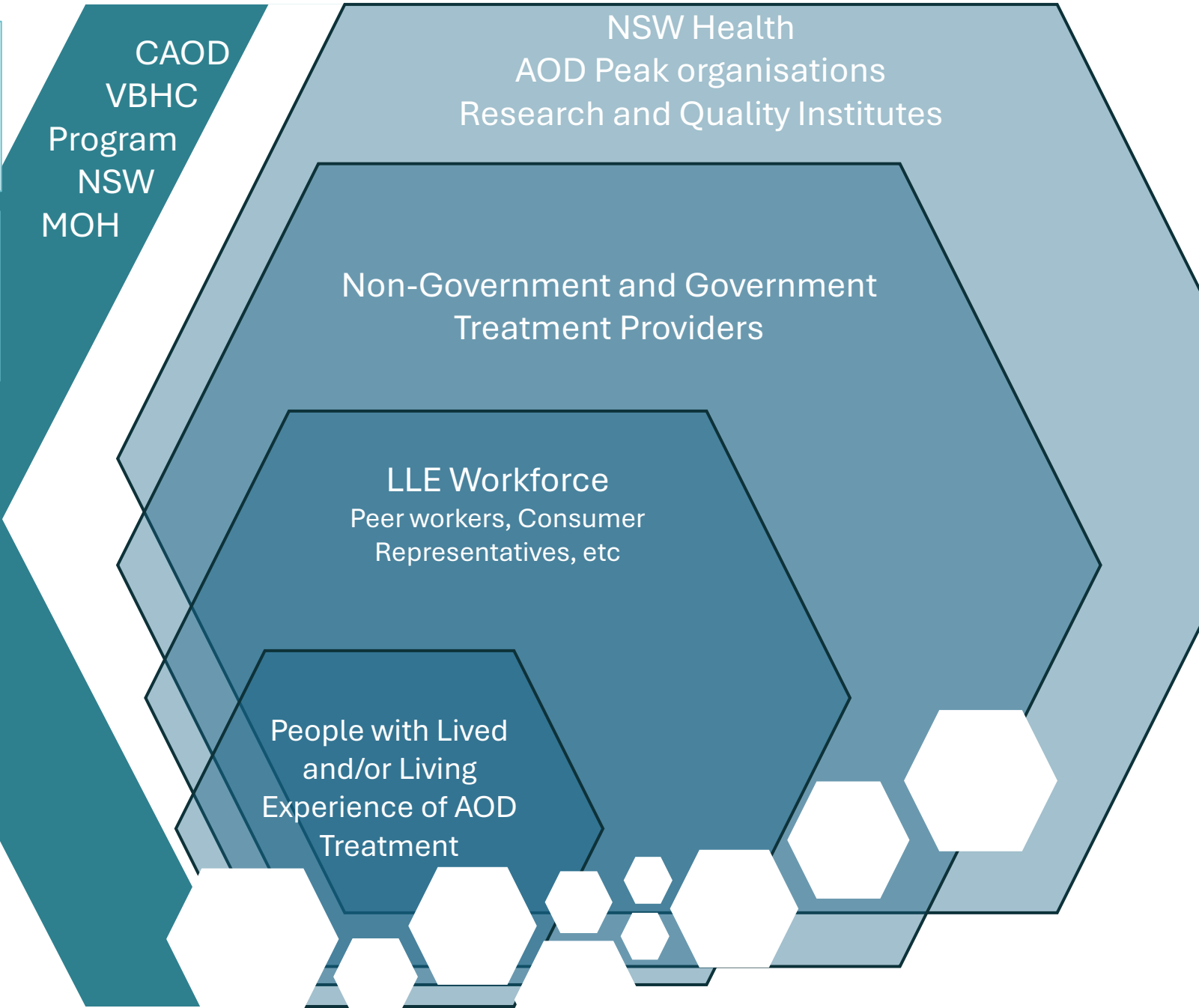
Define an AOD Value Based Health Care framework and strategic plans to provide direction and certainty for the sector  
**Framework and Strategic Plans**

Facilitate treatment provider integration of the Clinical Care Standards to improve the quality and safety of treatment  
**Clinical Care Standards Integration**


Improve the use of Person Reported Measures (PRMs) to review and improve treatment outcomes and enhance the experience of care  
**Person Reported Measures**

Build capacity to access, interrogate and interpret service VBHC data, including clinical care standards, PRMs and cost of delivery data  
**Data capacity for AOD VBHC**

Establish a benchmarking program for AOD treatment  
**AOD Benchmarking**

# Conclusion

In bringing value-based health care to life in NSW are focussed on:

- Supporting the delivery of care that is better structured around a person's health journey, and delivered in a way that supports more seamless access
- Improving the collection and use of data with clients to improve their own treatment and improving the governance and infrastructure to use the same data at a service and system level
- The implementation of the NSW AOD Clinical Care Standards to create a common language, a professional standard, build the health literacy of people in treatment, provide touch points for information collection
- Leadership, organisational culture and partnerships that support safe learning environments are critical to use VBHC data
