









Countries with National Hepatitis Plans (May 2017)

Stigma Remains a Huge Barrier for Patients



- 93% of countries surveyed reported stigma and discrimination to some degree
- 72% of respondents suffered from self-stigmatisation
- 53% of respondents had been socially isolated
- 52% of people had experienced unjust barriers to healthcare
- 42% had lost out on job opportunities or income
