**Find out more about:****About C-FREE Clinic: BMA New Step Ladprao**

This centre is a public health facility operated by the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA), situated in an urban area of Bangkok. The BMA clinic provides community-based harm-reduction services, notably methadone maintenance therapy. C-FREE clinical services managed by DLP operate daily in one clinic room of the centre, and patients/participants are referred by the BMA centre staff. The model is also operated in other community centres operated by NGOs.

**About C-FREE and Dreamlopmments Foundation (DLP)**

The C-FREE study is a community-based model of care for the diagnosis and treatment of hepatitis C and other infectious diseases (HIV, HBV, STI, TB) in high-risk groups;

people who inject drugs, men who have sex with men, transgender persons, and their partners, using DAAs).

The C-FREE-2 study currently implemented in 12 DiC across Thailand (including at BMA Ladprao) uses the DAA combination Sofosbuvir/Ravidasvir for the treatment of participants with active HCV infection. DLP is one of only a few organizations and programs currently using Ravidasvir around the world and generating information on real-world effectiveness to support global adoption.

The visit takes place within an operational public health clinic. Services will continue during the visit and delegates are kindly requested to respect patient privacy and confidentiality at all times.

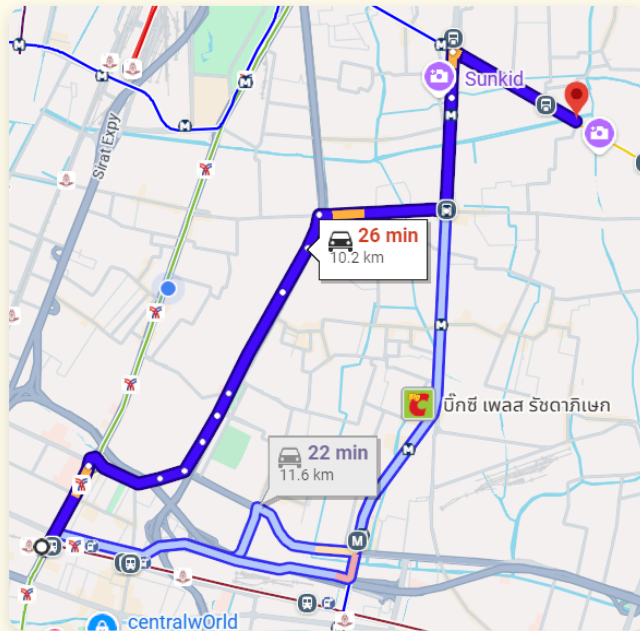
### Taxi Route (Recommended)

**Estimated fare:** 250–300 ฿ (depending on traffic)

**Distance:** ~10.5 km

**Travel time:** 25–35 minutes

Tip: Use Grab or Bolt app for fixed pricing



### Public Transit Option

**~60 min**

BTS Green + MRT Blue + MRT Yellow • Total: ~79 ฿



#### Walk to Phaya Thai Station

Short walk from Eastin Grand Hotel to BTS Phaya Thai Station

~3 min walk



#### Take BTS Sukhumvit Line (Green)

**Board:** Phaya Thai Station

**Direction:** Khu Khot (Northbound)

**Get off:** Mo Chit Station (5 stops)

**Price:** ~40 ฿ (Rabbit Card or single ticket)

~10 min ride



### Transfer to MRT Blue Line

Follow signs to MRT Chatuchak Park Station  
Connected via covered walkway inside the station

~5 min walk



### Take MRT Blue Line

**Board:** Chatuchak Park Station

**Direction:** Lak Song

**Get off:** Lat Phrao Station (2 stops)

**Price:** ~20 ฿ (Token or single ticket)

~3 min ride



### Transfer to MRT Yellow Line

Follow signs inside Lat Phrao Station to Yellow Line platform

Same station, no need to exit

~3 min walk



### Take MRT Yellow Line

**Board:** Lat Phrao Station

**Direction:** Samrong (Southbound)

**Get off:** Phawana Station (1 stop)

**Price:** ~19 ฿ (Token or single ticket)

~4 min ride



### Exit & Walk to Clinic

Exit Phawana MRT Station (Exit 1)

Walk along Lat Phrao Road towards the clinic

**Clinic:** คลินิกกัวใหม่พลัส ลาดพร้าว

**Address:** 900 Lat Phrao Rd, Samsen Nok

~5 min walk

📍 Trains run every 5-10 minutes

🚇 BTS: Rabbit Card or single ticket (~40฿)

🚆 MRT: Token or single ticket (Blue ~20฿ + Yellow ~19฿)

👛 Total fare: ~79 ฿
