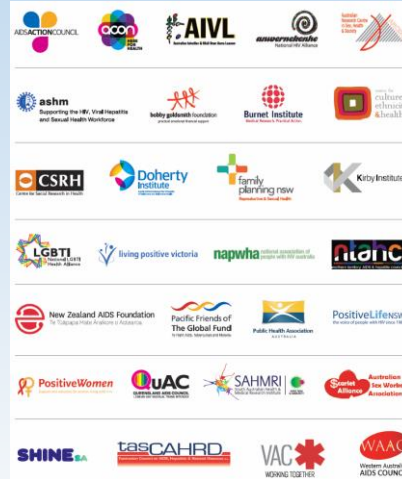

To achieve the Strategy's goals, we must:

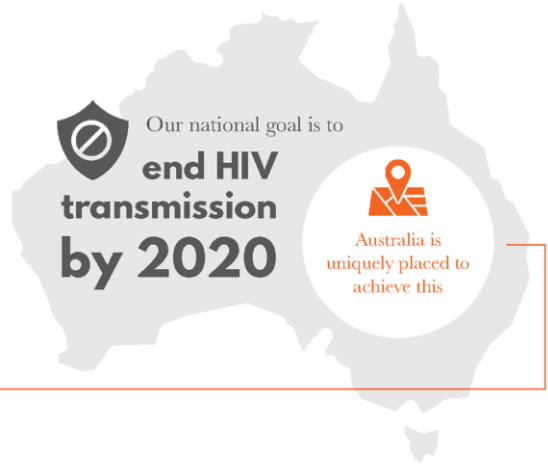
- know our epidemic

Australia can end HIV transmission

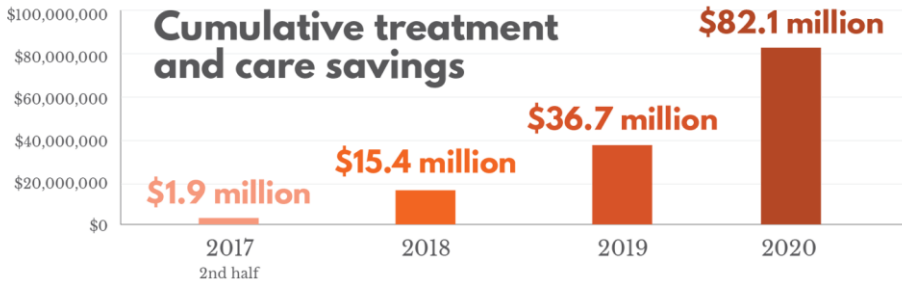
A powerful combination of new science and decades of experience means Australia can lead the world and end the HIV epidemic.
