



Preparing for your Poster Tour

If your abstract has been accepted as a poster tour presentation, this will involve a 3-minute presentation, 2-minute Q&A in a dedicated poster tour session.

General information:

- **Location:** Exhibition Hall
- **How It Works:** Participants/ presenters will use colour coded 'silent disco' headsets and handheld microphones. Each tour is assigned a specific headset colour for ease of identification for sessions running concurrently.
- **Meeting Point:** Head to the poster tour headset desk in the exhibition hall to collect a headset in your tour's colour, then proceed to the first poster on the tour.
- **Presentation Format:** Presenters will have 3 minutes for their presentation, followed by 2 minutes for questions and answers.
- **Session Chair:** A designated chairperson will oversee each poster tour, ensuring presentations stay on schedule and facilitating the Q&A.

Presentation tips:

- What is this project/research about? (30 seconds)
- How did you do it? (and with who)? (30 seconds)
- What did you find? (1 minute)
- What does it mean? (30 seconds)
- What are the next steps (for research and clinicians)? (30 seconds)
- Ensure that you clearly articulate key implications for communities, practice, policy and/or First Nations communities
