- There's lots of talk about who should be treated, by whom & where






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What's going on here?

- Assessment of timing & help with choices. Prioritise & Planning
- Links with Tertiary services for cirrhosis & other Liver Disease
- Window of opportunity for brief interventions -Prenoxad Script & training
- QuiCS Training-Safe IDU
- **HBV Vax & Sexual Health** screen & treat



- Try to engage & enable Primary Care Provider
- Maximise use of the resources of PCPs
- Provide reliability & consistency
- Be visible and approachable to staff
- Provide education, updates to staff

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Lessons Learned & Challenges Ahead

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- That I am much more useful serving this community by taking treatment to the people
- The care that is provided by this outreach service is enhanced by the team approach - Synergistic & Gestalt IT NEEDS A TEAM
- There are Clinicians (think GPs) who just want to do this & we should leave them be.
- There are Clinicians (think GPs) who SHOULDN'T do this.
- To not provide holistic care to this cohort of people is negligent i.e. lives are saved by Prenoxad (think Demi Lovato).
- Be more than a DAA dispensary this may be only health care service this person is accessing.
 - The challenge is to continually adapt to the changing terrain.
 - How far "out" can outreach go & are there other ways?
 - Try to find a "balance" between quality & quantity whilst providing a streamlined service
 - Don't get caught up too much in the numbers game
