Barriers to service provision for CALD sex workers



- Criminalisation of sex work





How SWOP helps break down barriers for CALD sex workers in NSW

- Attend cultural competency courses
- Provide peer/ translated resources
- · Provide interpreting support
- Let CALD sex worker lead and do not assume you know what is best for CALD sex workers. Ask CALD sex workers.
- Support decimalisation of sex work
