Priority Areas

A Blueprint for ACON, Government, Health Practitioners, Service Providers and NGOs to Improve the Health and Wellbeing of the Trans and Gender Diverse Community in NSW

Priority A	Clear and easy pathways for accessing gender-affirming care
Priority B	Affordable and available gender-affirming healthcare
Priority C	An inclusive and knowledgeable NSW health sector
Priority D	Official government I.D.s and records that reflect trans and gender diverse people's gender through simple administrative procedures
Priority E	Workplaces, education settings and other environments that are inclusive and respectful of the needs of trans and gender diverse people
Priority F	A vibrant, resourced trans and gender diverse community advocating for its own needs and priorities

MAR 2017

- Mid-term review of Strategic Plan: TGD Health Outcome Strategy identified as priority for development

DEC 2017

- Discussion paper released: Effective and Meaningful Inclusion of TGD People in HIV Prevention

NOV 2017

- ACON establish staff working group to develop the Strategy

JUL 2018

- ACON announce TGD Advisory Group to develop Strategy
- Second TGD Advisory Group meeting held
- Discussion paper completed: 28 priority areas identified

JUL to SEP 2018

- Stakeholder interviews held: 23 TGD community leaders, GPs, endocrinologists, sexual health physicians, NSW Health officials and LGBT human rights lawyers

JUN 2018

- First TGD Advisory Group meeting held

APR 2019

- Launch at Parliament House

MAR 2019

- Launch preparation and planning

FEB 2019

- Fifth TGD Advisory Group meeting held
- Board approves draft
