

Tackling PLHIV Isolation and Unemployment

- A survey was conducted in 2015 of 66 clients
- More than 60% of respondents would like to do some form of volunteer or paid work (with an approx. 50/50 split).
- When asked how employable PLHIV were on a scale of 0-10 (where as an example, 0 represents no skills, motivation and/or confidence) the mean was 5.22.

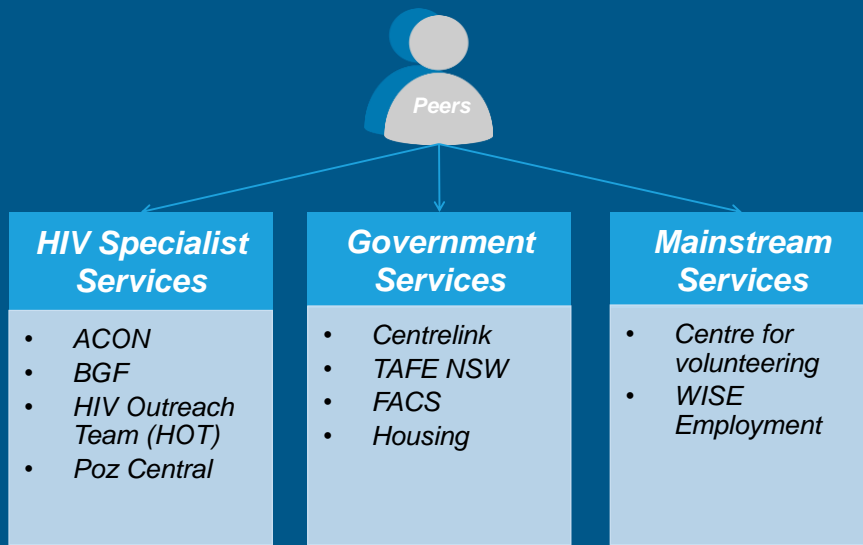
The Needs of PLHIV

- Lack of meaningful supports to help set and achieve goals

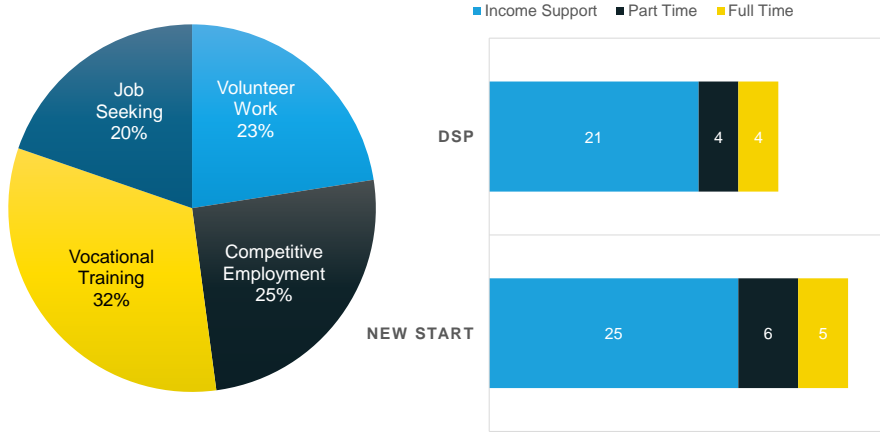
