## Assessing sporting clubs interest in taking action on illicit drugs

- To build capacity for Good Sports clubs to lead on drug prevention
- To increase the confidence of club officials to tackle illicit drug issues
- · To increase number of clubs with a reasoned illicit drug policy

19 community forums in Victoria in 2014/15

- · Included discussion of drug use nature, statistics, motives, risk and protective factors
- Identified enablers and barriers for clubs
- Post-survey of attendees (n=654) Response rate: 49.5%

Key results for club committee members:

- 73% more confident to support someone with a drug issue after this session
- 90% more aware of resources and services to help someone
- 80% thought their club is likely to develop a policy
- 94% felt more confident to develop illicit drug policy
