SENIOR VOICES PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Address the challenging issues of HIV, sexuality, sex and ageing with senior PLHIV speakers
- Educate aged care providers and staff on the needs of senior PLHIV
- Break down HIV stereotypes and stigma
- Ensure inclusion and visibility of older PLHIV in Aged care
- · Strengthen the resilience of senior PLHIV



PROJECT APPROACH WHAT WE DID

- Innovative, peer-based community engagement for speaker training and support
- · Resources on models of care excellence for PLHIV
- Built aged care sector networks and knowledge of aged sector workforce training
- Assessed level of HIV knowledge in aged care sector



THE POWER OF PERSONAL NARRATIVES

- The human face of HIV challenging myths, stigma and discrimination
- Powerful education sessions about living and ageing with HIV, sexuality, sexual health, HIV medication, comorbidities
- Empowered older PLHIV to self advocate for their health and well being

- Education and capacity development
- · Best practice principles and policies
- Inclusive person centred care
- Empowering PLHIV, care workers & carers

SPEAKER RECRUITMENT & TRAINING ISSUES, SOLUTIONS AND OUTCOMES

- Many struggled with disclosure of sexuality and HIV stigma. WHY?
- Reformatting our peer and health promotion programs supported older speakers with greater peer-to-peer engagement
- One on one mentoring, support and coaching improved speaker recruitment retention.



ENGAGING THE AGED CARE SECTOR ISSUES, SOLUTIONS AND OUTCOMES

- LGBTI training a higher priority for the sector
- Senior Voices project was unique among all other funded projects
- Little understanding of the power of personal narratives in changing attitudes
- · Ambivalence versus eagerness
- Success

- · Refocus on core principles of peer support




THE FUTURE
