- Eliminates feelings of shame.

## In-language educational comedy

- Written by the community for the community.
- A family's story on coping with a hepatitis B diagnosis.
- 1st show in August 2017, 2nd show in April 2018
- Free hepatitis B testing and FibroScans for audience members after the play.

#### Education

- Myths lead to hepatitis B stigma and discrimination.
- Addressing common hepatitis B myths.
- Correcting misinformation without shame nor judgement.





## Eliminating fear

- Fears around an individual's reputation in the community.
- Fears around the consequences of having hepatitis B.
- Following an individual's journey with hepatitis B.

#### Guidance

- Poor language proficiency.
- Lack of familiarity with Australia and its systems.
- In-language guide on how to navigate Australian healthcare system.





#### Results

- 1000 Chinese Australians have watched the play inperson.
- All actors and actresses tested for hepatitis B.
- 95% of people would test for hepatitis B.
- Many audience members requested for more inlanguage edutainment in the future.
