I don't have a great deal of knowledge about STIs but I have had a lot of sex, both with committed and casual partners. I don't like condoms as they reduce pleasure and are unreliable. I have been STI tested a few times, it's pretty normal to get STIs when you have a lot of sex. STIs usually have symptoms.





Play Safe refresh + inclusions

Focus tested with young people from the 2 high risk segments.

Play Safe now features real-life imagery and peer-topeer tone of voice for improved engagement with young people.

Website Features:

- STI susceptibility quiz "Could I have an STI?"
- STI testing service locator
- Community forum hosted by trained youth peer moderators
- Nurse Nettie Q&A with 24 hour response time with sexual health nurse
- Play Safe also hosts Down to Test and Take Blaktion program webpages.





Socials: design / content / tone: > 70% like it / really like it


