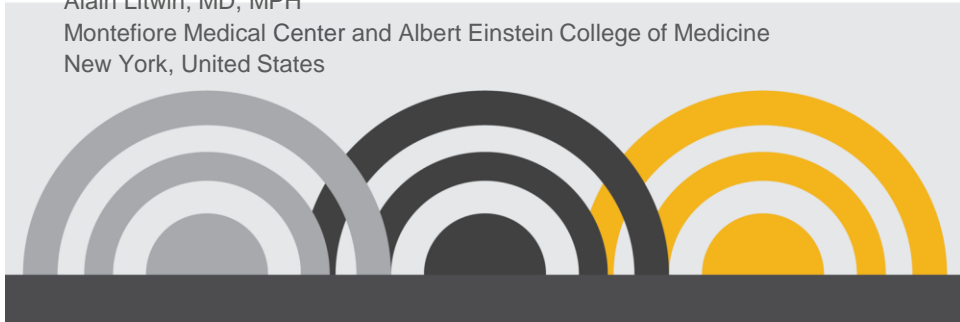

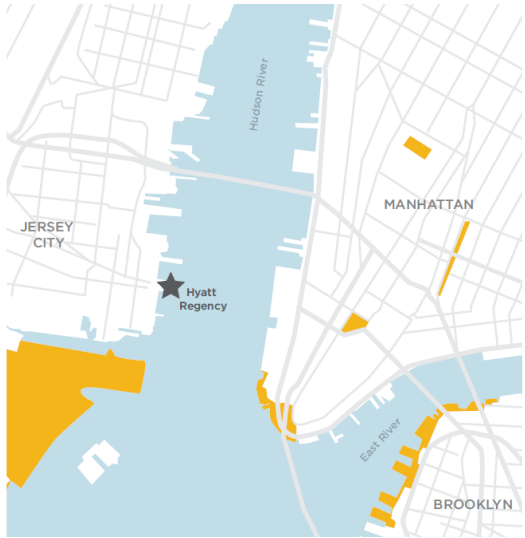

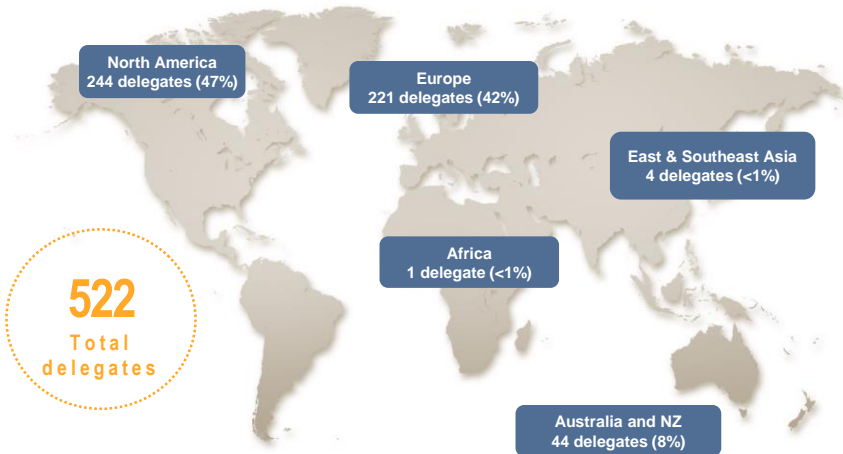
- Facilitate scientific exchange and dissemination of knowledge

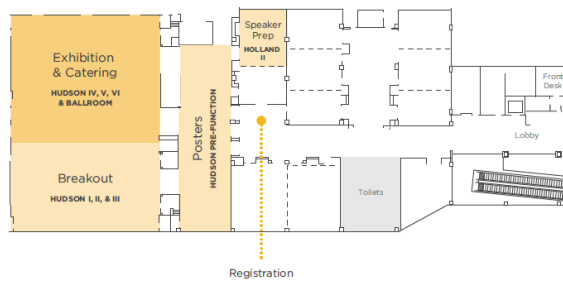
## INHSU 2017 Scholarships

- This includes targeted scholarships for community people and practitioners working in harm reduction settings through support from Open Society Foundations

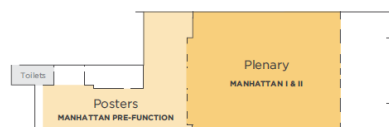


## INHSU 2017 Meeting Space

## Language at INHSU 2017

- Language is important

- For example, when using an acronym in slides, such as PWID, just say “people who inject drugs”
