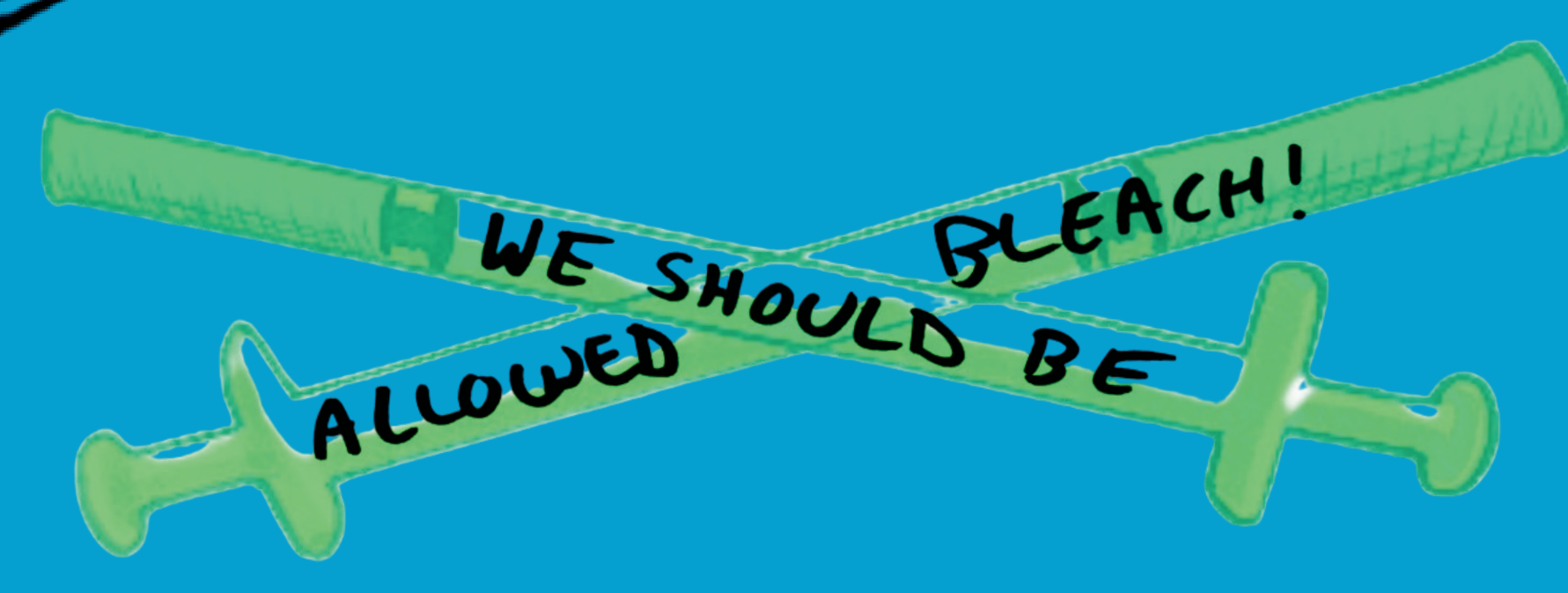
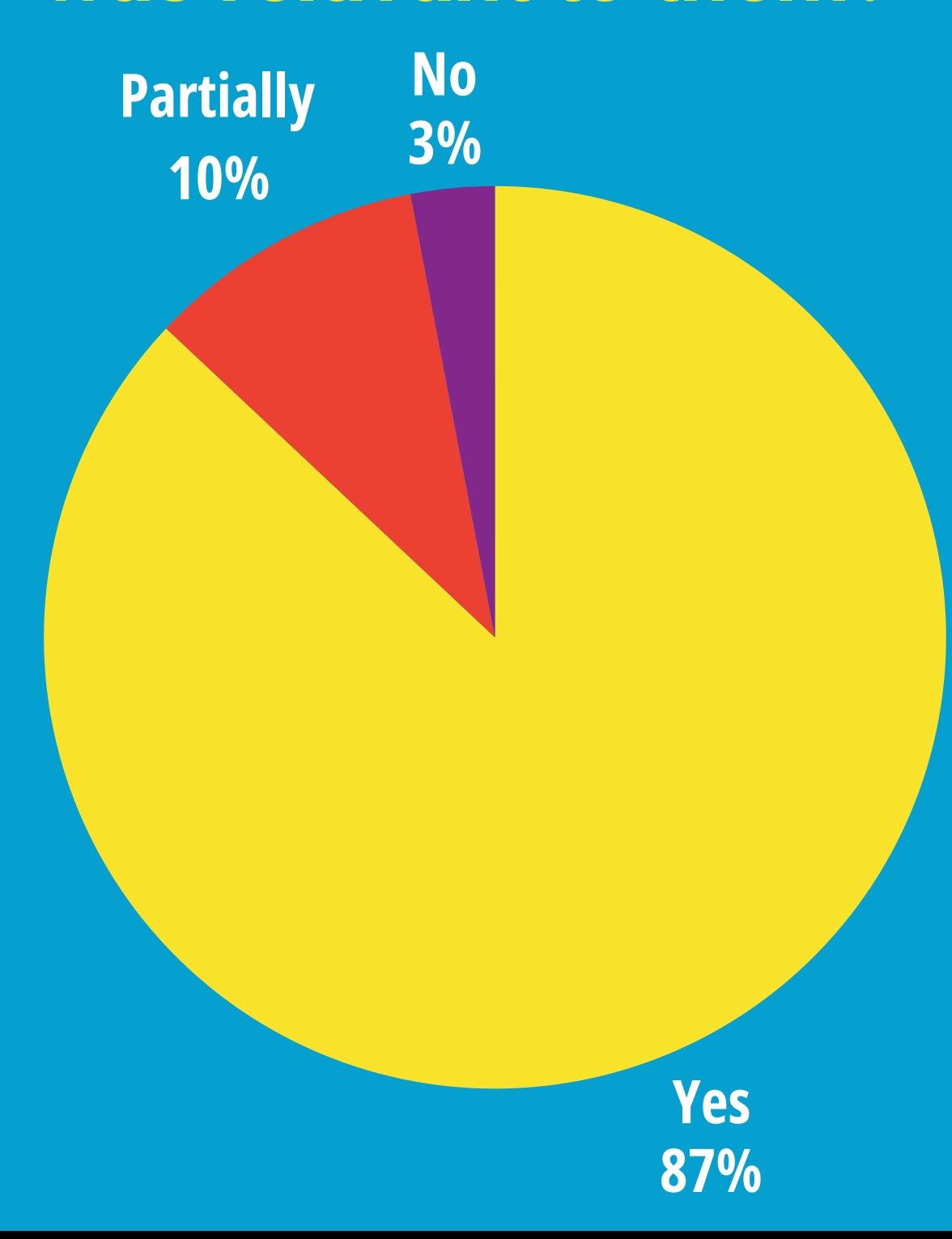




Participants were asked if this was relevant to them?



The *Sex, Drugs & BBVs* : become a harm reduction expert, program covered a range of specialised harm reduction topics including safer injecting, vein care, drug interactions, BBVs, drugs and the brain.

Participants reported 100% improved knowledge across all sessions, learning practical and empowering tools like:

Feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with participants expressing deep respect for the peer facilitators and calling for the program to continue.

Many shared that it challenged their assumptions and helped break down stigma, highlighting the power of peer-led harm reduction in custodial settings.
