SUPPORTING GPS TO DELIVER MTOP

Despite the availability of Mifepristone on the PBS medical termination of pregnancy remains inaccessible to many women. General practitioners, the major providers of contraception and sexual health services to women in Australia, are ideally placed to provide this service however they have not yet adopted or integrated MTOP into their practice in large numbers. This presentation will outline the barriers and enablers GP's face in providing MTOP and explore models of service delivery that could be implemented to mainstream MTOP in the general practice context. It will also outline a new initiative being undertaken by the RACGP to provide support to GPs in this area.
