# LET'S SAVE 50 AOD CLIENTS

## (from becoming an AIHW burden of disease data!)

Why 50?

Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW, 2018) statistics: Illicit substance use attributes to 3% of the disease burden in Australia, of which 15% is suicide and self-inflicted injuries.

Contextually, 15% of the current 337 Liverpool Drug Health (LDH) clients = 50 clients Therefore, 50 Alcohol & Other Drugs (AOD) clients are at risk of suicide and/or self-harm!

# A case for change

#### FLAG MENTAL HEALTH RISK

Flag clients with Mental Health diagnosis at initial assessment. Put a red sticker on their medication card as an identifier.



#### LOOK FOR ANY MENTAL HEALTH CONCERNS

Identify signs & symptoms of mental health deterioration for clients attending clinic daily.

#### DO A MENTAL HEALTH RISK SCREENING

Progress to completing a Mental Health risk screening on the Electronic Medical Record (eMR).





### COLLABORATE!

Form a multi-disciplinary collaborative care plan with Mental Health and other relevant services.
