A Harm Reduction Nurse-led Model for Hepatitis C Reinfection and Treatment Completion



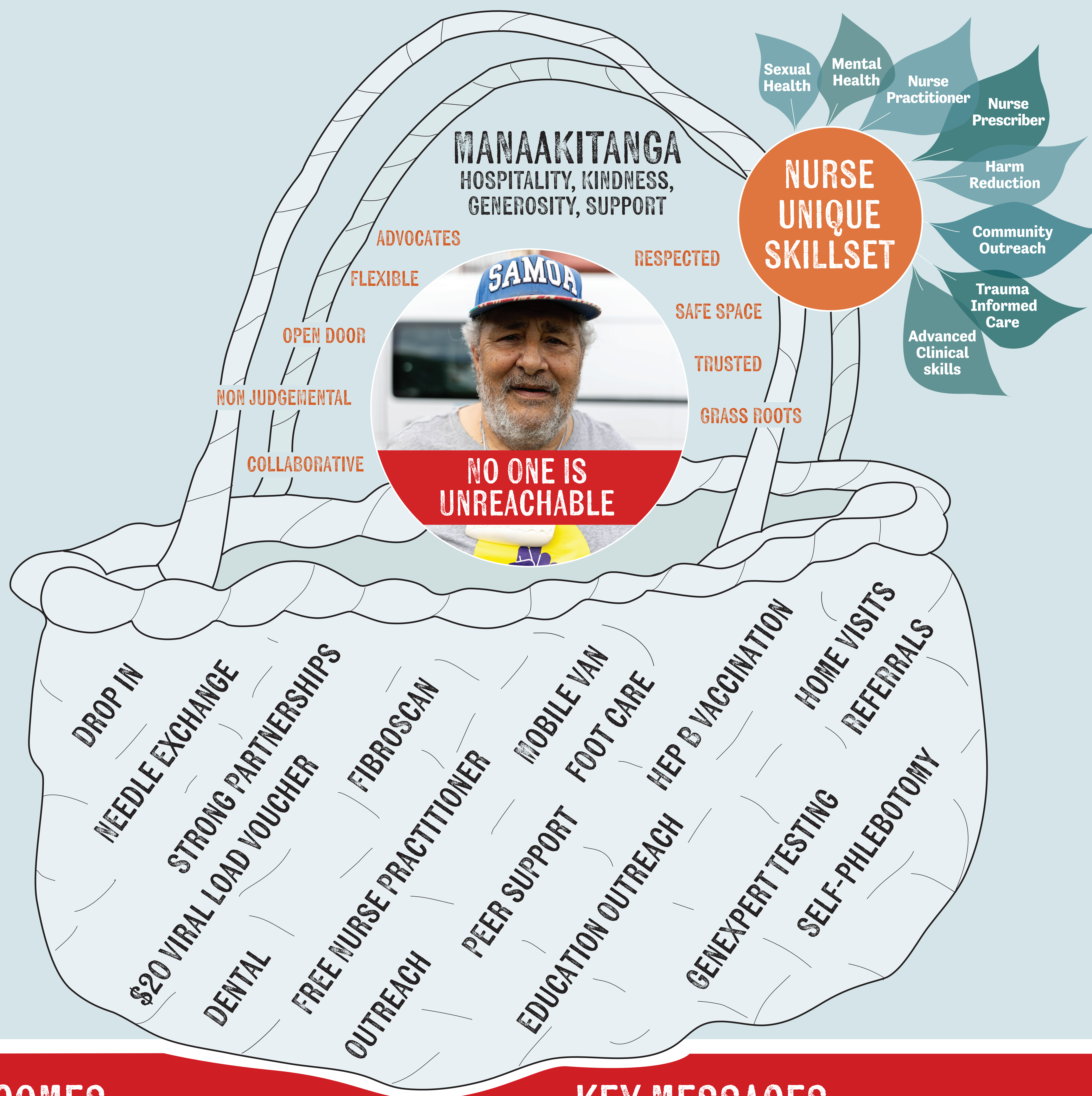
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BACKGROUND

- The nurse-led **Rodger Wright Community Clinic** co-located with the peer-led Needle Exchange improves access to hepatitis C testing and treatment for people who currently or previously use drugs.
- **Innovative approaches** remain essential to reach priority populations.
- Our nurse and peer model proactively meets people where they are, ensuring **easy access to treatment and retreatment**.



OUTCOMES

- **423 treated Maviret** (2019-2025)
- Canterbury **highest treatment rates** in New Zealand
- **>10% retreated**
- Reach those **missed by mainstream** services

KEY MESSAGES

- **Open door** for retesting
- Retreatment **reduces Hep C prevalence**
- **Flexible models of care** needed
