



WHAT DID WE FIND IN JUNE 2022?



We Tested 358 Men

Tested	358	49% of prison pop
Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status	29%	Of All tested
History of injecting drug use	79%	With Detectable RNA
HCV RNA prevalence	39%	
History of prior Rx	49%	With Detectable RNA
Treatment uptake	88%	Within 6 Weeks





WHAT DID WE FIND IN NOV 2022?



Tested	309	38% of prison pop
Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status	39%	Of All tested
History of injecting drug use	77%	With Detectable RNA
HCV RNA prevalence	22%	
History of prior Rx	55%	With Detectable RNA
Treatment uptake	98%	Within 4 Weeks





WHAT WAS THE CHANGE BYFEB 2024



3rd VISIT : 536 Men Tested - Increase of 15% of pop

Tested	536	49% to 66% of prison pop
Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status	36%	Of All Tested
History of injecting drug use	68%	With Detectable RNA
HCV RNA prevalence	17%	39% to 17%
History of prior Rx	62%	With Detectable RNA
Treatment uptake	98%	Within 4 Weeks






