SUBMIT ABSTRACTS

PSANZ is a multidisciplinary society dedicated to improving the health and long term outcomes for mothers and their babies. We encourage research focused on mothers and babies during pregnancy and at birth as well as the health of the newborn as its development continues after birth. We receive abstracts from a broad range of scientists, clinicians and researchers.

There are three formats for presentation at the congress;

- An oral presentation will receive a 15-minute time slot with the opportunity for a 10-minute presentation and 5 minutes for questions and discussion.
- A 5 minute oral and poster presentation.
- A poster presentation will be on display in one of two poster and networking sessions throughout the congress.

Abstract submission closes November 11th!

Perinatal Substance Use (PSU) Research Awards

This award is sponsored by the Perinatal Substance Use Sub-Committee and will be awarded to the best presentation (oral or poster)

1st Prize: \$1,500 and 2nd prize: \$500 for best research abstract related to perinatal substance use presented at the PSANZ Congress.

Self-nomination for consideration for the PSU Award must be made at the time of abstract submission.

Eligibility:

The award is open to any abstract, regardless of the status of the investigator or whether the investigator has won the award previously. To be eligible for the PSU Award the applicant must:

- be a PSANZ member at the time of presentation
- be the presenter and first author of the abstract

Note: abstract reviewers will be asked to confirm that the abstract meets the relevant theme of this award. If not deemed relevant to the theme the abstract will be ineligible and not judged.

Award will be announced on the final day of Annual PSANZ Congress
