Quick note on terminology!



- Drug consumption room / Supervised consumption site
- Supervised injection site or facility
- \odot Medically supervised injecting centre or facility or service

DCRSCSSISSIFSICMSICMSIR

Essential bits



- Welcoming, non judgemental spaces
- Drug use allowed (generally only self administration)
- \circ Drug pre obtained
- \circ Harm reduction approach

Variable bits

- Routes of administration
- Staff
- $\,\circ\,$ What services onsite / model of care



<u>Uniting</u>

Evidence

- $\circ~$ Reduced death and injury from overdose
- Reduce BBV transmission
- Reduce public drug use and discarded equipment
- \circ $\,$ Increase access to treatment and care $\,$
- Importantly: no increase in community drug taking, no increase in relapse rates, and cost effective

What we've achieved so far



17,757 people registered





Zero deaths in 20 years



We have made 19,028 referrals in to health and welfare services.



overdoses successfully managed without a single death



The number of discarded needles and syringes in Kings Cross almost halved when Uniting MSIC opened, and ambulance callouts to overdose dropped by 80%.





2001 MSIC opens. First supervised injecting centre in English speaking world.
