





The Project

- HIV Work Ready is a Positive Life NSW reengagement & employment initiative
- It is a peer led service navigation and engagement model between HIV and mainstream service providers
- It is a peer led project helping PLHIV return to paid and volunteer work on their own terms









HIV Work Ready - Case Story

Kelly-Anne was referred to work ready by BGF staff. She is a 42 y/o mother of 3, and proud grandmother to 1. She has been a DSP recipient since 2009 and lived with HIV since 2001. Initial face to face meeting and enrolment with peer to program 1st week of August '17. Commenced a volunteer role with ASHM by late August. Accepted a part-time casual role with Coles in early October and is now in the final stages for recruitment to a customer service role with NSW Trains
