NUAA has collaborated with NSW Health to issue public drug alerts since 2018

- Committee participation: help to determine whether the alert will be issued and review wording
- Issue alert via NUAA social media channels (NUAA and DWNSW Instagram and Facebook)
- Follow up with further harm reduction (e.g. naloxone distribution, liaising with other community organisations)

DRUG WARNING

High dose MDMA (ecstasy) tablets have recently been found in NSW – purple shield-shaped tablets

Know the risks

- · You are at increased risk of harm if you:
- Take multiple MDMA (ecstasy) tablets or capsules
- Use other stimulant drugs (e.g. amphetamines or cocaine) at the same time
- XX Take MDMA in a hot environment like a music

The purple shield-shaped tablets contain 150mg of MDMA.

This is a higher dose than usually expected.

HIGH DOSE MDMA (ECSTASY) PILLS

High dose MDMA pills recently detected in NSW. These pills contain a higher dose than usually expected in MDMA pills circulating in NSW.

The pills are purple coloured and come in a shield-like shape*. The pills contain 150mg of MDMA.



*Tablet appearance is not a reliable indicator of drug contents.

- MDMA pills and caps are often poorly made and the MDMA dose can vary, even within the same batch.
- Always start low, with a half or quarter if taking pills or caps, regardless of how familiar you are with a substance.




Drug Alerts Issued Since 2019













Social media traction - NUAA

Real time festival alert

- A substance sold as MDMA was found to contain
 Nitazenes at a NSW music festival in early 2024
- Onsite stakeholders collaborated to issue a warning at the festival
- No lives were lost this collaborative response was possible through the NSW music festival response & guidelines years of relationship building within the festival space

When a seriously ill Sydney raver 'set off alarm bells', a DJ stepped in to avert a nightmare scenario

Medical experts at the HTID festival at Olympic Park realised a dangerous synthetic opioid was circulating and acted fast to save lives








Naloxone orders have increased...


- NUAA commenced distribution of naloxone via the NSW Take Home Naloxone (THN) program in 2022
- Distribution has steadily increased to over
 400 units per quarter (postal only)





... alerts drive up Naloxone orders

- Orders tend to increase post alerts for opioids in cocaine
- Limited data set
