Why?



- Counselling feedback
 - Older Gay/Bi men expressing difficulty in connecting
 - · Missed out on the "social media revolution"
- Limited places for older Gay/Bi men to socialise in Canberra and the surrounding areas
- · Navigating the uniqueness of Canberra's guarded scene
- Community discussion
- MAGNET in Sydney gave permission to use the name

How?



- Advertising through networks:
 - Facebook / Twitter
 - Community discussion boards/ Community groups
 - Counsellors/ Clinical staff
- Intake process for men to ensure compatibility or referral to other services programs as required
- Series of Saturday workshop events held monthly
- Stand alone sessions participants could attend one or all

How?



- Peer facilitated
- Group set goals for what they wanted to achieve/learn
- Facilitators created content to respond to topics raised
- Ongoing communication with participants between sessions

Topics



Some of the topics discussed:

- Being gay/bi and growing older
- · Growing older and finding a partner
- Navigating the social media apps
- Dealing with stereotypes the 'gay' look
- Safer Sex what if something goes wrong
- Navigating Canberra's unique 'guarded' scene
- Coming out while married

Process



- 20 men enquired through the AIDS Action Council
- 6 to 10 participants at each session
- After the workshop series social gatherings at cafes & pubs
- Participants encouraged to catch up independently

Outcomes



- · Took a break for the winter months
- Returned in the spring with new sessions
- Renewing with social events in 2018, e.g. movies, dinner nights, cafes.
