

2023 NDARC Annual Research Symposium Terms and Conditions

By registering for this Event, you agree that these Terms & Conditions govern your registration and participation at the Event. The Event is organised by The University of New South Wales (Organiser), ABN 57 195 873 179, UNSW Sydney NSW 2052. All references to “delegate” and “you” in these Terms and Conditions mean the registrant listed in the registration form.

1. Event

2. Registration entitlements

Access to all the Symposium sessions

Access to all recorded sessions to watch on-demand for a limited time after the Event; subject to the Organiser’s receipt of each speaker’s permission and if the recorded session meets the Organiser’s quality requirements

3. Fees

This is a free event and there is no registration fee

4. Delay, Reschedule or Cancellation of 2023 NDARC Symposium

NDARC at UNSW reserves the right to change any of the published event details and have the final determination on any matter relating to the event. The Organiser may at any time and at its discretion reduce the scope of, postpone or cancel the Event. Should this occur, the Organiser will provide as much notice as possible and if the Event is cancelled, the Organiser will refund your registration fees in the same form as the original payment. In the event of cancellation, you agree to discharge the Organiser of any liability from any claim arising out of or in connection with the cancellation of the Event.
