

Abstract Submission – Terms and Conditions

By submitting an abstract, the submitting author confirms acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

1. Eligibility and Originality

- Abstracts may have been submitted to, or presented at, other scientific meetings unless otherwise stated by the Conference Organisers.
- The submitting author confirms that all co-authors have reviewed and approved the abstract prior to submission.

2. Accuracy and Ethics

- The submitting author is responsible for the accuracy of all content, including data, references, and author details.
- All research involving human participants, animals, or sensitive data must have received appropriate ethics approval (or exemption), where required.
- Abstracts must comply with relevant ethical, legal, and professional standards.

3. Submission Requirements

- Abstracts must be submitted via the official conference submission portal by the stated deadline.
- Abstracts submitted after the deadline may not be accepted.
- The Conference Organisers reserve the right to reject abstracts that do not comply with formatting, word limits, or submission guidelines.

4. Review and Acceptance

- All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee.
- Acceptance decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- The Conference Organisers reserve the right to determine the presentation format (oral, poster, e-poster) and session allocation.

5. Registration and Presentation

- At least one author must register for the conference by the nominated deadline for the abstract to be included in the final program.
- Failure to register may result in withdrawal of the abstract without notice.

- The presenting author must ensure availability to present at the scheduled time.

6. Publication and Use of Abstracts

- Accepted abstracts may be published in the conference program, website, mobile app, abstract book, and/or associated publications.
- By submitting an abstract, authors grant the Conference Organisers a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to reproduce and distribute the abstract for conference-related purposes.
- Authors retain copyright of their work.

7. Amendments and Withdrawal

- Abstract amendments may be permitted up to the stated amendment deadline.
- Abstracts may be withdrawn by the submitting author in writing prior to the withdrawal deadline.
- Withdrawals after acceptance may not be reflected in printed materials.

- The Conference Organisers accept no responsibility for errors or omissions in submitted abstracts.
- Submission does not guarantee acceptance.
