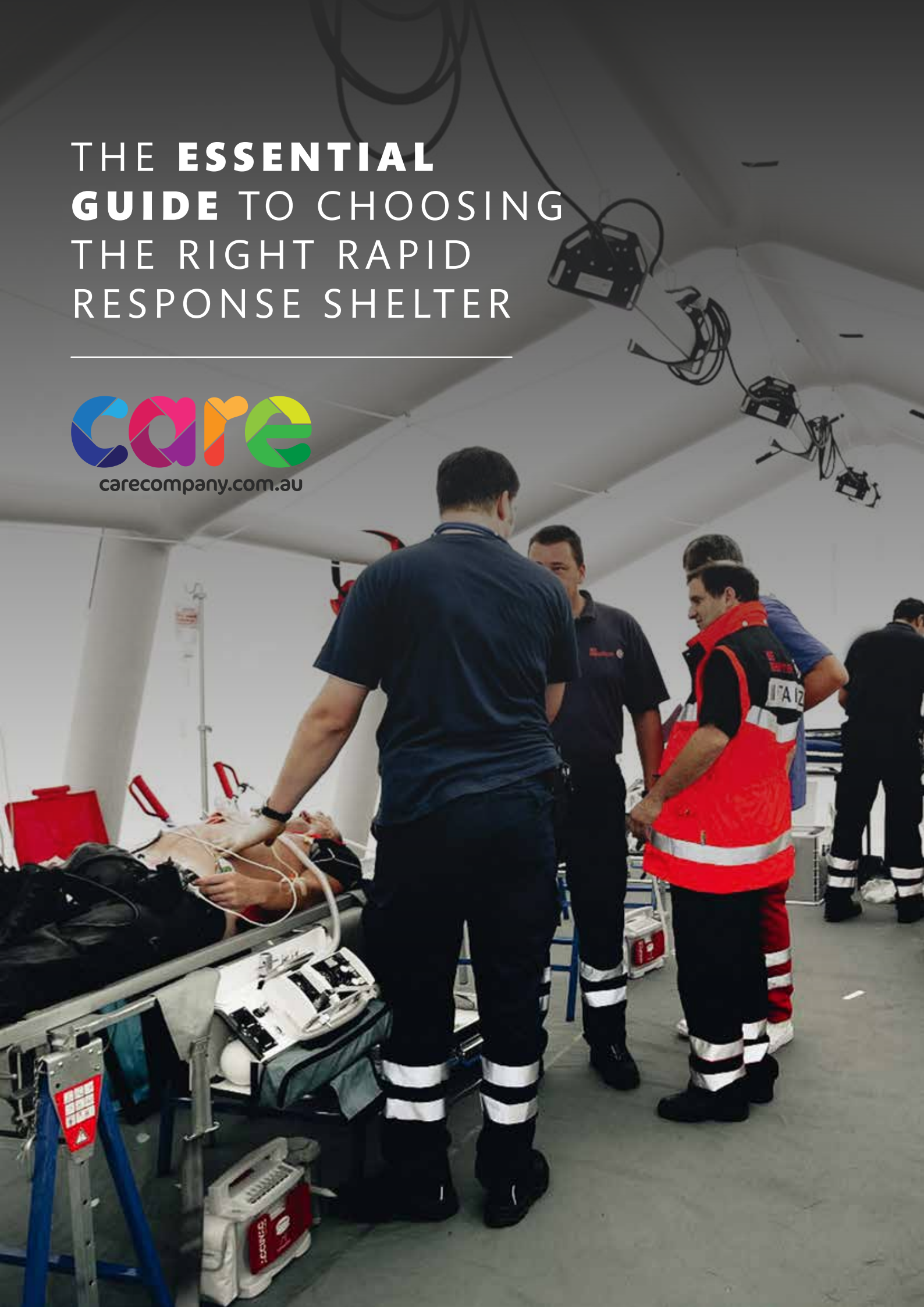

Ease of use

Think about how easy your shelters should be to set up and dismantle, as efficiency during emergencies is paramount. Our inflatable shelters can be set up in 5–10 minutes by 1–3 people, while our exoskeleton shelters can be deployed by 2–5 people in less than 15 minutes.

How long will you need to use the shelter for? Will it be a temporary shelter for hours or days, or a longer-term base camp or accommodation for days, weeks or months? This is a key factor in choosing the type of shelters you need and the way your operations team will set up and dismantle them.

Having the appropriate shelter that suits your specific needs can make all the difference.



Safety

The environment in which the shelter will be deployed plays a significant role in its effectiveness. The shelter must be able to handle the severity of any weather conditions in that environment.

Sun, rain, dust and wind can all be challenges. Choosing a shelter with structural integrity provides a safe area for the occupants to use.

LANCO shelters are designed to provide occupants with a safe place. We have recently completed wind tunnel testing on inflatable and framed shelters so you know that they can perform at wind speeds in excess of 100km/h with gusts up to 120km/h.

Our shelters are interconnectable, which means they can be joined to other shelters and accommodate a larger group. So, without any additional planning you can deploy shelters to meet the needs of any size of response.

Our range of lights provide you with a scalable system that is best in class: an immense amount of light with minimal power consumption, with 110V, 240V or solar-powered options that are robust, plug-and-play and cost-effective.

Internal insulation, heating and cooling are also key in providing a comfortable space. We ensure that we provide the internal configurations you need to meet your needs.

Textiles and colours

Not all shelters are manufactured with the same quality of textiles. We offer immensely strong textiles that can handle Australia’s harsh environment by being fire, UV and mildew resistant as well as waterproof.

Generally, light colours perform better in the Australian climate, as they reduce the thermal load from the sun. We manufacture textiles in about 10 colours.

In high-risk environments, such as a medical, flood or bushfire response, we recommend using the highest grade of textiles for reliable deployment. LANCO textiles last for repeated usage and provide the best return on your investment.





Storage and maintenance

Simple logistics is another key part of your solution. A shelter that is difficult to store and maintain can quickly deteriorate.

Our shelters are easy to store in a trolley or cage or on a pallet.



Cleaning and disinfection: LANCO shelter materials are easy to clean and disinfect, reducing the risk of contamination. They can be cleaned with regular soap and water, and are manufactured from materials that once dry, can be packed and safely stored long-term.

Easy to repair: Should there be any damage, repairs can be conducted by your operations team, either in the field or in your workshop. Every shelter is supplied with a repair kit and a 3-year warranty.
