

Corrosion & Prevention 2025 – Ticket Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all ticket purchases for **Corrosion & Prevention 2025**, organised by the Australasian Corrosion Association (ACA). By purchasing a ticket, you agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Ticket Purchase and Registration

- All attendees must register via the official Corrosion & Prevention 2025 website or an authorised ticketing partner.
- Full payment is required to confirm registration. Tickets are not confirmed until payment is received.
- A confirmation email and receipt will be sent upon successful registration.

2. Ticket Categories

- Ticket types (e.g. Early Bird, Standard, Student, Group) and pricing are outlined on the event website.
- Proof of eligibility may be required for discounted or student registrations.

3. Cancellations and Refunds

- Cancellations made in writing more than 40 days prior to the event will receive a refund, minus a \$300 administration fee.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations made within 40 days of the event.
- You may nominate a substitute delegate at no additional charge, provided notice is given at least 7 days before the event.

4. Event Changes and Cancellation

- The ACA reserves the right to alter the event program, speakers, venue, or dates at any time.
- In the unlikely event that the conference is cancelled, the ACA's liability is limited to the refund of paid registration fees only. Travel and accommodation costs will not be reimbursed.

5. COVID-19 and Health Safety

- Delegates must comply with all public health and safety guidelines in place at the time of the event.
- If government restrictions prevent attendance, the ACA will offer flexible options including ticket transfer, virtual participation (if available), or refund (minus admin fee).

6. Photography and Recording

- By attending the event, you consent to being photographed, filmed, or recorded. These materials may be used for promotional and educational purposes by the ACA.
- Personal recording or distribution of sessions without prior permission is prohibited.

7. Code of Conduct

- All delegates are expected to conduct themselves professionally and respectfully.
- The ACA reserves the right to remove any individual from the event without refund for disruptive or inappropriate behaviour.

8. Privacy

- Personal information collected during registration will be used for event management purposes and to communicate relevant updates.
- Your details may be shared with sponsors or partners unless you opt out during registration.

- The ACA will not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, or inconvenience caused by circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to natural disasters, acts of terrorism, or health emergencies.
