Educational and architectural ideas:

Baldivis Secondary College is a dynamic school in Perth's growing southern corridor designed to initially accommodate a total of 1200 students.

The epicentre of the school is the Learning Workshop, a 120 metre long undercover space that acts to link the school's main learning and social hubs. The library, student services, teaching block and café are all accessed from under the cover of the Learning Workshop whilst the Performing Arts and Gymnasium bookend the space, both opening out to create outdoor teaching and performing spaces under the cover of the principal roof space. The café acts as the heart of the hub, directly interfacing with the learning centres at ground floor whilst the café roof links the upper level classrooms and forms an auditorium seating space for student gathering and impromptu performances outside of the gymnasium.

The library, café and student services buildings reinforce JCY's endeavour to provide groundbreaking learning and knowledge access in the Western Australian school environment. Interactive education, wireless communications access and multi-purpose learning environments stimulate the student population and provide a gateway to the world both physically and virtually.
