



Moree Plains Shire Council Master Plan and Infrastructure Plan



Engaged with Indigenous communities for the Moree Plains Shire Council (MPSC) to identify significant Indigenous cultural sites, in a municipality spanning 17,928 km² that may be impacted by a 20-year housing development strategy, through:

- > Selecting representative community members to form an Indigenous working group to identify significant archaeological sites and recommend how these sites are to be managed
- Developing culturally appropriate procedures to ensure informed consent was obtained for all working group members before conducting site investigations
- Identifying "Design with Country" principles, opportunities and recommendations to ensure the voice of the local Indigenous community could be incorporated into the Master Plan
- Preparing an Indigenous Framework to acknowledge and protect Indigenous knowledge and artefacts, and identify their value and significance to the broader community

Engaged with Indigenous communities in the New England Renewable Energy Zone for a 5-year AUD\$2b pumped hydro storage project to:

- ➤ Plan and facilitate targeted "Town Hall" and one-on-one meetings with key Indigenous and non-Indigenous stakeholders
- Identify potential impacts of the project on Indigenous Land and cultural heritage and values, and develop and implement strategies to manage and mitigate these impacts
- Prepare a First Nations Engagement Plan to guide the management and protection of Indigenous cultural heritage
- ➤ Initiate and deliver a First Nations community program, commencing with a series of engagements with H.E. Dorcas Makgato, Ambassador of Botswana to Australia.

I once again thank you and the entire team for the warm welcome and fruitful discussions and look forward to working with you on various issues in the future for our mutual benefit.




