There are approximately 900 million hectares of sandy soils worldwide, particularly in arid or semi-arid regions. Southern and Western Australia alone have more than 22 million ha of arable sands. These soils are often impacted by multiple constraints, such as soil acidity, hardpans and soil water repellence while also have inherently poor fertility and a limited capacity to store water and nutrients. Australia is the leading global supplier of mineral sands, a critical source of titanium minerals, zircon and other minerals, which are exported to more than 35 countries. Coastal lime sands are a crucial source of high-quality lime for agriculture and industry. Sandy landscapes are homes for world-recognised biodiversity bringing the challenge of effective rehabilitation and protection of native vegetation systems. Addressing the challenges associated with sands require multi-faceted research skills and strategies, diagnostic methods and management approaches.

This conference will build and strengthen the international network of researchers with expertise on sandy soils. The conference theme, 'Shifting Sands to Sustainable Solutions', focuses on the challenges of managing and protecting the natural capital of sandy soils in the face of a changing climate.
