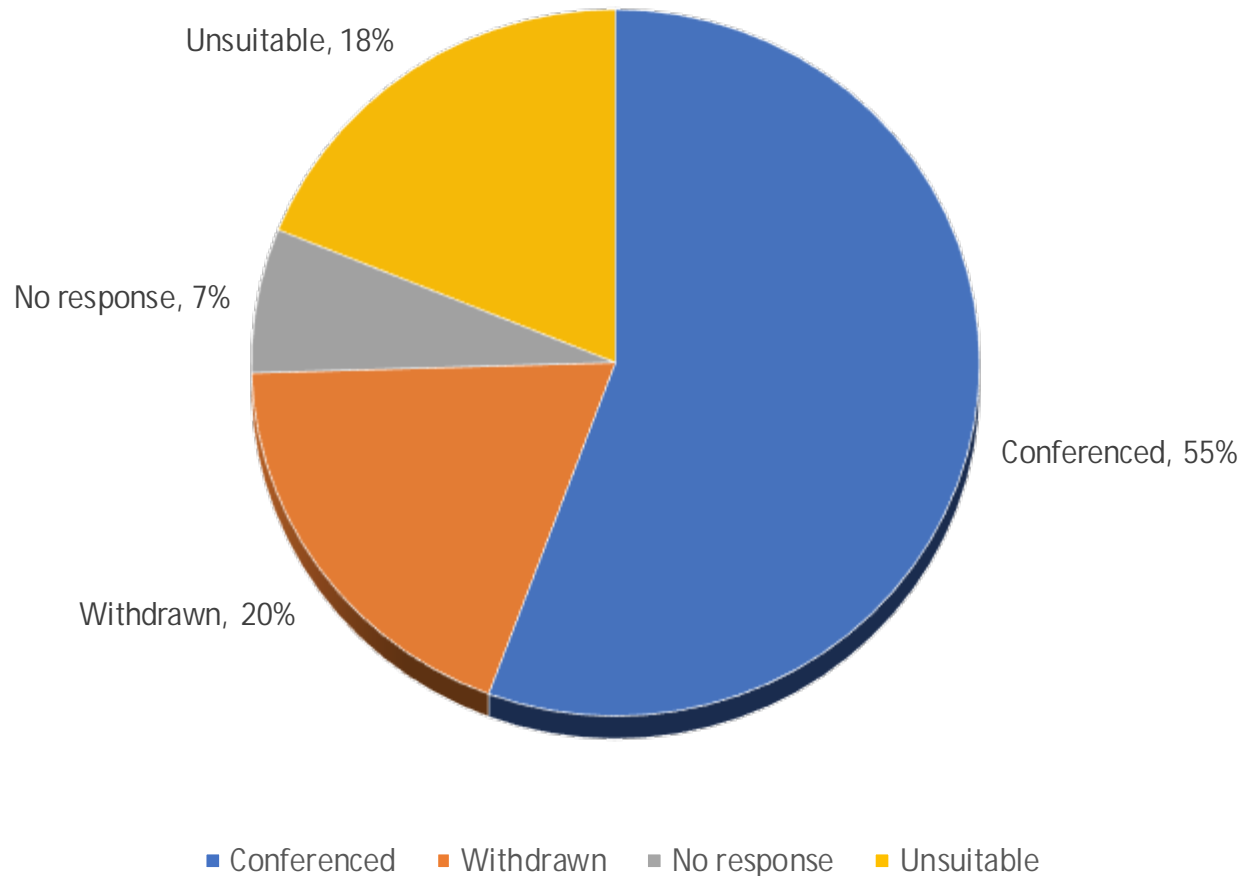

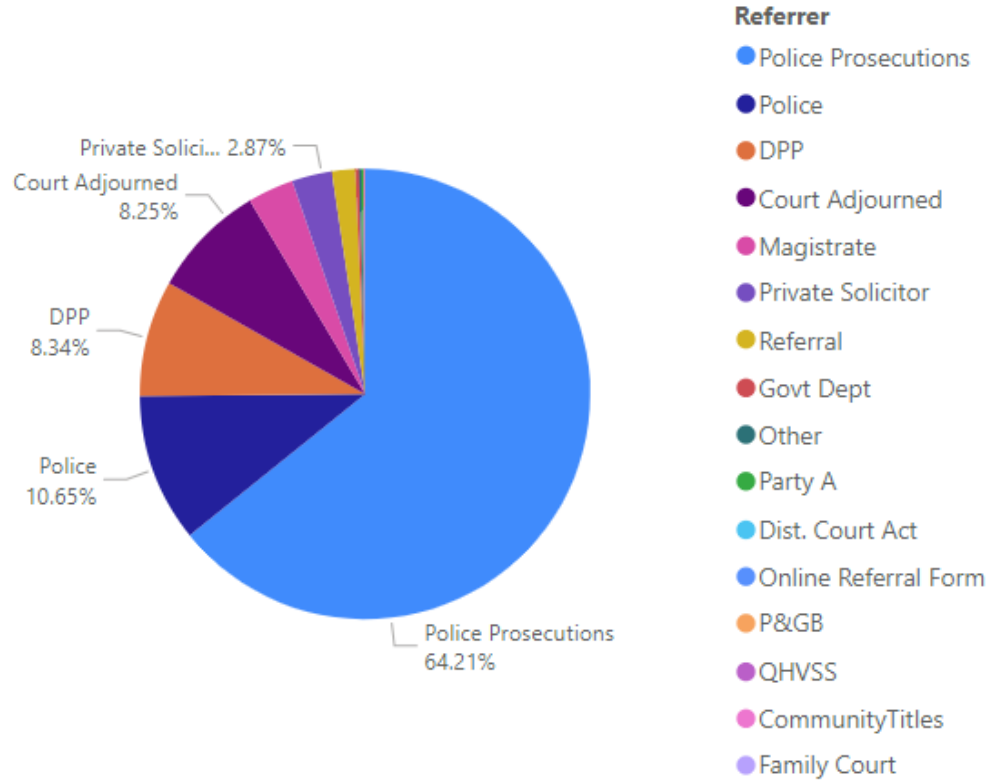

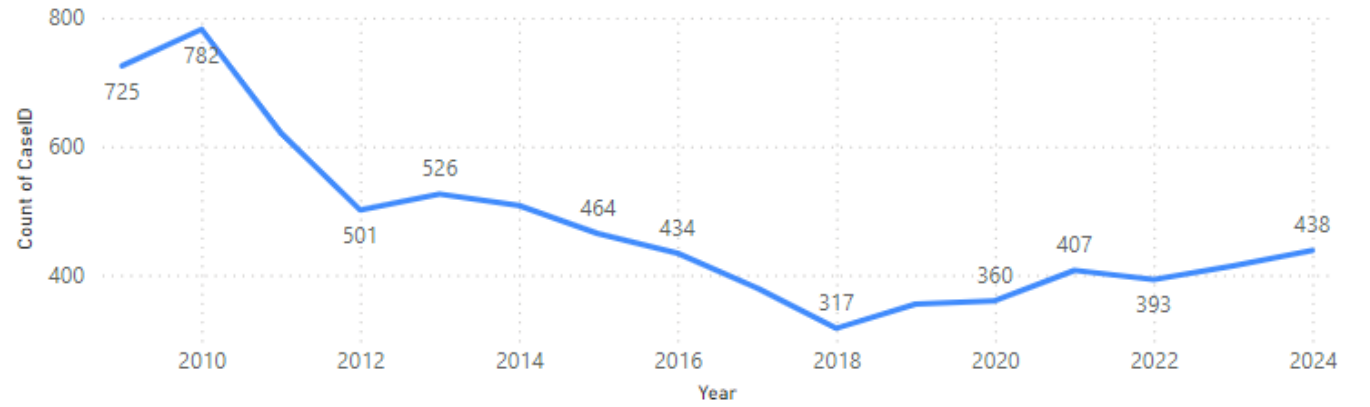

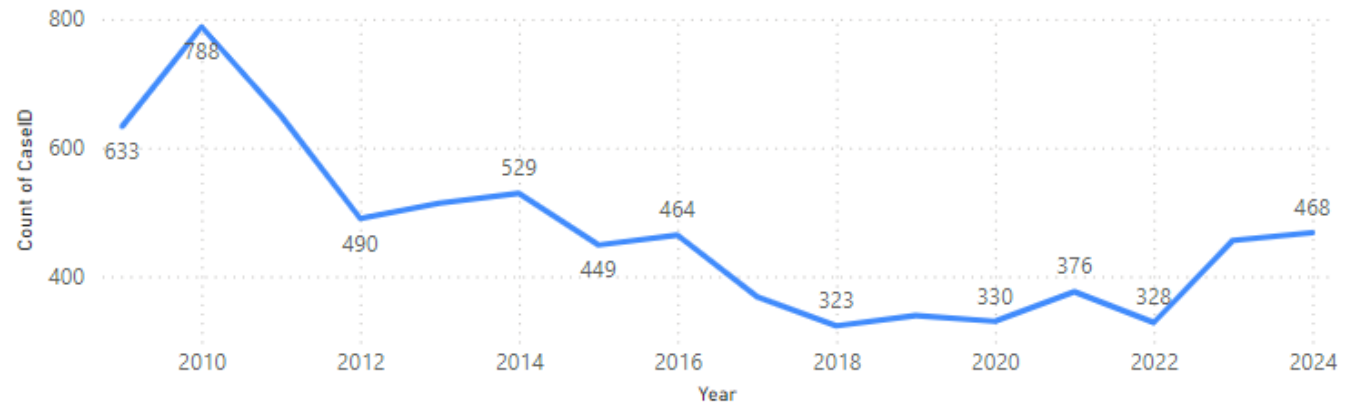
Count of Cases by Referrer 2009 - Present



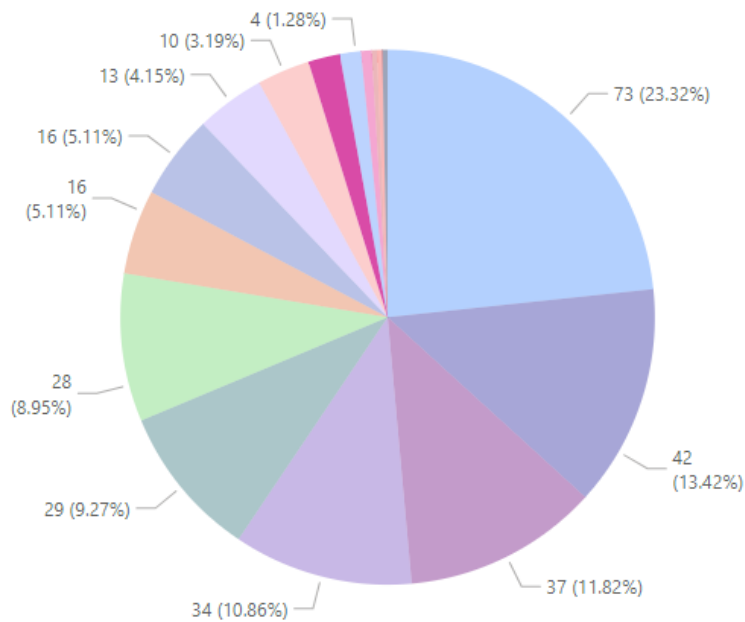
Number of Referrals by Year



Cases Closed by Year



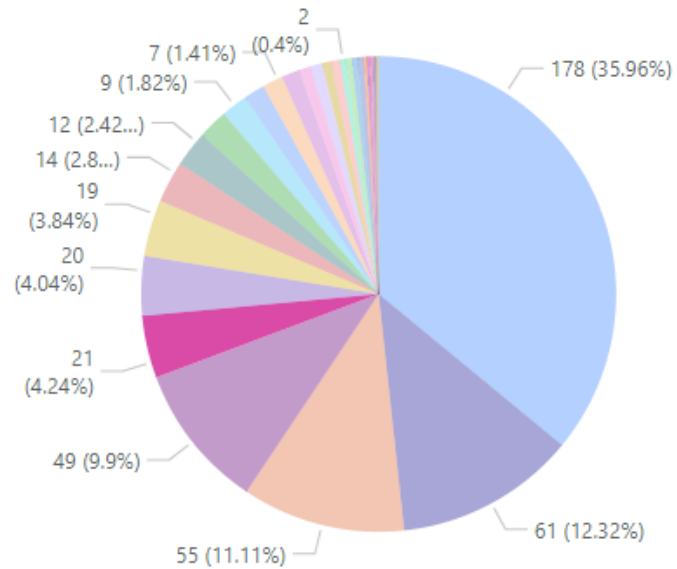

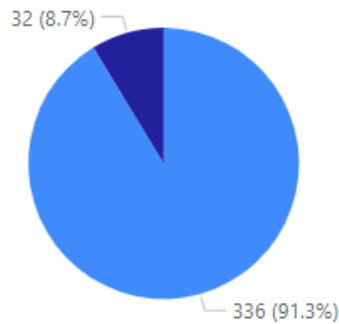

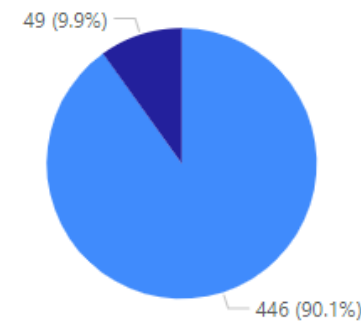
