






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Restorative Approaches in Schools

Restorative convenantors are held when issues arise between todividuals. Commonly satisfactions and are informal

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Restorative Conversations are also used when issues arise with more than 1 student involved and are informat.

Facilitated conversations or Mini Conferences are held when issues asias between individuals or small groups, commonly staff and students, or students and other students, where more support is needed to held the situation. This is a semi-formal approach


