- A crisis 20 years in the making
 - National fragility in supply chains for construction
 - Under investment and high levels of homelessness
 - Under investment and disinvestment by the public sector
 - Lower incomes
 - Planning induced shortages of land often induced by overlapping objectives
 - Too little infrastructure provided by state governments
 - Unaffordable housing and low quality housing
