A/Prof Vincent Tse

Dr. Vincent Tse is currently Clinical Associate Professor at the University of Sydney, and Macquarie University Hospital, Sydney. His special interest is in the investigation and management of all types of urinary incontinence, bladder functional disorders, urethral strictures and pelvic organ prolapse surgery, including robotics. He is a member of the Standardization and Terminology Committee of the International Continence Society (ICS), the current chair of the Female and Functional Urology Section of the Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand (USANZ), and the Scientific Co-chair for the International Continence Society Annual Meeting in Melbourne 2021.

Dr Tse has been an invited speaker and surgeon, both locally and internationally, including the USA, Europe and Asia. He and his team recently published the first bi-national guideline on management on the adult overactive bladder in Australia and New Zealand. Dr Tse was a member in the Transvaginal Mesh Committee of the Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Healthcare (ACSQHC) in 2017-2018. He has co-edited two books on urinary incontinence and the pelvic floor and authored many papers and abstracts in the area of functional and reconstructive urology. He is an advocate of multidisciplinary care in the management of incontinence and pelvic floor disorders. His hobbies include swimming, tennis, hiking and jazz.

A/Prof Henry Woo

Henry Woo is urological surgeon subspecialised in the treatment of prostate disease. He is Professor of Surgery at the Sydney Adventist Clinical School of the University of Sydney and Head of Department of Urology at the Sydney Adventist Hospital. He is also the Director of Uro-Oncology and Professor of Robotic Cancer Surgery at the Chris O'Brien Lifecare cancer centre in Sydney. He is also has been a pioneer in the development of minimally invasive therapies for benign prostate disease and has extensive experience in the management of prostate cancer and has published over 170 manuscripts in peer reviewed journals. He serves on the editorial boards of *Prostate Cancer Prostatic Diseases*, where he is an Associate Editor, as well as *European Urology*, *BJUI*, *World Journal of Urology*, *Prostate International*, *World Journal of Men's Health* and *PLOS One*. He is also a Board Director of the Australian and New Zealand Uro-genital and Prostate Cancer Trials Group (ANZUP) and the Australasian Urological Foundation (AUF).
