Dr. Iris Brown is the current President of United Nations Youth Australia, a volunteer organisation operated by young people to empower Australian youth through educational programs and facilitated discussions on topics in global, national, and local politics. UN Youth Australia holds consultations with young Australians through the Youth Representative program, elevating their voices to the UN in New York.

Iris has completed a Bachelors of Arts majoring in International Relations and Arabic Language and Culture. She received first class honours for her thesis on Public Intellectuals in the Syrian anti-regime social movement, in which she interviewed Syrian intellectuals in Paris and Berlin, and travelled to Syria and Lebanon.

Iris works at Refugee Advice and Casework Service, where she manages a team of volunteers working to assist asylum seekers and refugees in Australia navigate the legal system and achieve justice, protection, and stability.
