Who can nominate for the Board?

The MSB constitution states that:

11.1 (i) An Appointed Director may be an employee or associate of a member but does not need to be.

- 11.2: A Director of the company will have skills, knowledge, learning or experience in one or more of the following areas:
 - a. Accounting and or financial management;
 - b. Law;
 - c. Corporate Governance;
 - d. Alternative Dispute Resolution;
 - e. Professional Standards; and
 - f. Such other area or areas of skill, knowledge, learning or experience as the Board determines from time to time.

In addition, it has been agreed that it is desirable for there to be a mix of geographic and demographic representation on the Board and representation of special interests such as indigenous interests.

Nomination and election process

The MSB constitution states that:

11.18: Election of directors

- a. A nomination of a candidate for election as a director of the company:
 - must be made in writing, signed by the member making the nomination, signed by a second member and be accompanied by the written consent of the candidate (which may be endorsed on the form of the nomination); and
 - must be delivered to the secretary of the company at least 21 days before the date fixed for the holding of the annual general meeting at which the election is to take place or such other time as the directors may resolve from time to time.
- b. If the number of nominations received is equal to or less than the number of Elected Director vacancies to be filled, the persons nominated are taken to be elected unopposed.
- c. Any vacant positions remaining on the board are taken to be casual vacancies.
- d. If the number of nominations received exceeds the number of Elected Director vacancies to be filled, a ballot is to be conducted in such usual and proper manner as the board may direct.
