The project builds real skills and real leadership. It also makes sure people with intellectual disability have a say in how digital safety information is created and shared.

The Digital Champions:

- build leadership, confidence and public speaking skills
- learn about online safety and digital inclusion
- share advice on the program and its resources
- support other people with intellectual disability to be safe online
- help peers and community groups understand digital safety
